The Boeing Company ("Boeing"), by its attorneys and in accordance with Special Condition 5 of the above-referenced Special Temporary Authority ("STA"), hereby submits the attached certification of Eutelsat SA ("Eutelsat"). As set forth in the certification, Eutelsat has notified all satellite operators with co-frequency operations within ± 6 degrees longitude of each of Eutelsat Atlantic Bird 2 and Eutelsat II-F4 that these satellites are authorized points of communications for the experimental operations authorized by the STA. Eutelsat has provided the satellite operators a general description of Boeing's experimental operations, as well as points of contact within Eutelsat and Boeing for the purpose of resolving any complaints of harmful interference.

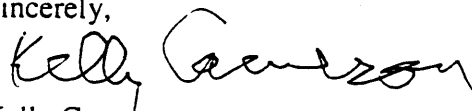

Dear Mr. Holman:

Pursuant to Condition 5 of the Special Temporary Authority ("STA") granted to The Boeing Company ("Boeing") on September 12, 2002 (Call Sign WC2XVE, File No. 0334-EX-ST-2002), Eutelsat SA ("Eutelsat") hereby certifies that it has notified all operators of co-frequency satellites within ± 6 degrees longitude of each of Eutelsat Atlantic Bird 2 and Eutelsat II-F4 that these Eutelsat satellites are authorized points of communication for certain aircraft earth stations that will test and demonstrate Connexion by Boeing two-way aeronautical mobile satellite services. Eutelsat has also provided these operators points of contact within Eutelsat and Boeing for the purpose of resolving any complaints of harmful interference, which the parties must resolve by adjusting or ceasing the operations authorized by the STA.
