Dear Robert B. Douglass,

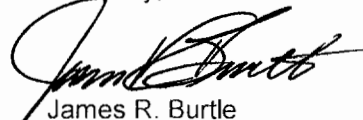
This refers to application, File No. 0515-EX-PL-2007, for Experimental Radio Station WE2XSL.

The enclosed authorization shall be considered as a grant of the referenced application unless rejected by a written notice within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter, whereupon the enclosed grant will be vacated. Such rejection should include a statement of the reasons, if any, why the applicant believes that the application should be granted in accordance with the terms requested therein.

You are advised that the Commission was unable to make a finding that the public interest would be served by a grant of the application in the manner requested. The frequency 1100 MHz was removed because it was returned without action from the FCC Spectrum Coordination Branch. The reason given is that the frequency is in an aviation AAG band and requires prior coordination with the FAA.
