1. For Trustcomm: We can support the Trustcomm Demo with the three conditions below. If you can also agree to these three conditions, please advise me the STAs number after you file with the FCC so I can look for them when the FCC send over to NTIA for coordination. Also just for my curiosity

... Are the Seatel patterns with or without radome?

a. All Boeing testing granted on an experimental basis shall be conducted IAW the configuration that was coordinated with AFSMO and on an unprotected, non-interference basis to authorized DoD stations.

b. This STA is limited to 6 months and is subject to re-coordination with AF (Jimmy Nguyen, Email: jimmy.nguyen@us.af.mil).

c. As soon as possible, but no later than 3 business days prior to any planned testing, Boeing is required to provide Jimmy Nguyen (Email: jimmy.nguyen@us.af.mil, AFSMO) and Travis J. Inghram (Email:

travis.j.inghram.civ@mail.mil, ARSTRAT)

with the planned testing date/duration and the stop buzzer POC for the testing. If planned testing is in conflict with DoD operations, additional evaluations and/or restrictions will be required.

2. For Insitu UAV Demo: Unfortunately, We need several more days to complete our analyses and coordination. As advised, My POCs have a very much back to back couple week meetings in UK and Japan. Also, as this is the first proposed airborne testing case, it takes more for us to do analyses and coordination.
