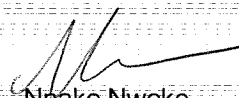
This refers to application, File No. 1140-EX-ST-2015, for an experimental authorization.

In accordance with G117, 20.2-21.2 and 30-31 GHz, the Federal FSS and MSS are limited to military services and is heavily used by Military throughout US&P. DoD will consider further coordination when Boeing has a DoD sponsor to conduct a demonstration.
