This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

- (3) KeyW Corporation must coordinate the Day 3, Leg 2, and Day 3, Leg 3 operations in West Texas and Eastern New Mexico with the DoD Area Frequency Coordinator, at White Sands Missile Range, DoD-AFC (WSMR), at least 96 hours prior to the flying this route. Coordination shall be via e-mail to usarmy.wsmr.imcom-central.list.dodaafc@mail.mil. Please include dates/times of these flights, the maximum flight levels, and an electronic copy of the final FCC license.
- (4) The KeyW Corporation must coordinate all flights near the National Radio Quiet Zone with Dr. Glen Langston, glangsto@nsf.gov or 703-292-4937.
- (5) The KeyW Corporation must ensure that emissions do not extend below 9.2 GHz.

- (7) Further requests for extension of the authority granted herein must be filed on Form 442, "Application for New or Modified Radio Station Authorization under Part 5 of FCC Rules - Experimental Radio Service." Future STA requests to extend this authorization will not be considered.
