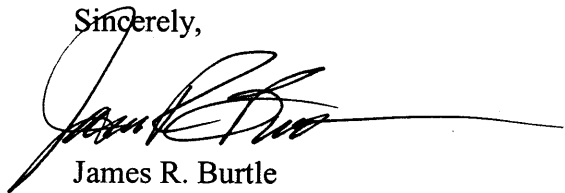
This refers to application, File No. 0086-EX-ST-2004, for Experimental Radio Station WB9XWN.
