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The MITRE Corporation researches, purchases and evaluates commercial equipment, to include modems, amplifiers, multiplexers and VSAT networks for U.S. government applicability. As part of ongoing evaluations MITRE leases satellite bandwidth to perform over-the-air research and evaluations of the commercial equipment and require FCC licensing. The MITRE Corporation has been performing these evaluations since December 2001 and will continue into the foreseeable future.
