NTIA has no objections as long as the following conditions are met to the FCC STA issuing a STA to Time Domain Corp. to be used at Rockville, from June 4, 2004 thru July 1, 2004:

1.) The FAA can only concur to outdoor tests if they are conducted in an area remote to aviation systems. Rockville is not suitable for the tests. Our office can assist in locating an acceptable area if necessary [202-267-9710]. Alternately, the test would need to be conducted in a building that would provide attenuation sufficient to bring the UWB emission down to Part 15 levels.

TIME DOMAIN provide to the Federal Communications Commission and NTIA data as outlined in the Code of Federal Regulations 47, Part 5 "Experimental Radio Service (other than Broadcast)" of the Commissions rules subpart B "Applications and Licenses" Paragraph 5.73 "Experimental Report" subparagraph b "The Commission may, as a condition of authorization, request the licensee to forward periodic reports in order to evaluate the progress of the experimental program."
