Dear Sue Pash,

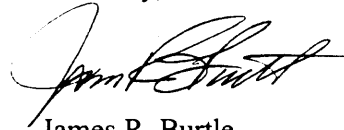
This refers to application, File No. 0225-EX-ST-2002, for an experimental authorization.
