



Request for Expedited Processing

TracStar Systems, Inc. (TracStar) respectfully requests expedited processing of its request for an Experimental License 0440-EX-PL-2007 filed on August 25, 2007. TracStar wishes to cancel its previous Special Temporary Authority (STA) application 0992-EX-ST-2006 filed in December of 2006. Because of the Commissions tremendous back log, TracStar was not contacted by the Commission until July 12, 2007 and subsequently was informed that we had filed the wrong application. TracStar has since filed the correct application 0440-EX-PL-2007.

Before the FCC, In the Matter of IB Docket No. 07-101, Notice of Proposed Rule Making, Amendment of Parts 2 and 25 of the Commission's rules to Allocate Spectrum and Adopt Service Rules and Procedures to Govern the Use of Vehicle-Mounted Earth Stations in Certain Frequency Bands Allocated to the Fixed-Satellite Service.

TracStar Systems is the original equipment manufacturer of Vehicle-Mounted Earth Stations and in anticipation of the Acceptance of the Notice of Proposed Rule Changes to Part 2 and 25 TracStar is filing for an Experimental License to conduct tests with our VMES systems and various modem types to insure proper operation and compliance to FCC Parts 2 and 25.

Operation tests performed at our manufacturing facility are such that they comply in particular as it relates to FCC Part 25.222.

Since the Commission often grants such requests, TracStar would appreciate special attention in this matter because of the potential for lost business within the commercial and government sectors of the satellite industry.

Several modem companies will need to test to the proposed compliances and there is no route for them to test with the integrated solution. TracStar has been granted licenses in the past (See 0489-EX-ST-2005) for such purposes. However, with the potential number of modem manufacturers who wish to participate in the Fixed Mobile services and the potential complexity of testing to the Commissions' compliance, TracStar will need an experimental time period longer than the STA will allow. Also, it is in the best commercial interests for TracStar to be FCC compliant with as many modem manufacturers as possible.

TracStar has filed for an Experimental License and the required Technical Brief and Test Plan exhibits for this very reason.
