

Exhibit A – Request for Experimental License Renewal

Toggle Communications LLC (Toggle) seeks renewal of its current experimental authorization for radio station license WI2XAJ (the License).

The FCC granted Toggle's original application for the License on November 6, 2015 for a two-year term.¹ Toggle modified its application on April 8, 2016, and the FCC granted Toggle's amended application on May 6, 2016.² The FCC did not change the License's expiration date when it granted Toggle's modification application. Toggle worked diligently to construct the License and completed construction in February 2017. Toggle has performed testing since completing construction but needs additional time for testing.

The FCC allows for renewal of an experimental license for a maximum period of five years.³ Toggle requests a five-year renewal term so that it can fully realize the benefits of its experimental equipment investment and continue to research the state of the art of radio transmissions in the high-frequency band.

Toggle has conducted [REDACTED] to determine the optimum design for a system operating on these frequencies. Additional testing [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Toggle will use the renewal term of the current experimental authorization to inform its analysis and design of future system modifications. Once the testing of the current configuration is complete, Toggle intends to submit a modification application to support a system redesign. A five-year renewal term will thus allow Toggle to continue its experimentation for experiments necessary to analyze current-system performance and identify potential improvements for future designs.

Toggle respectfully requests the FCC process its application promptly so that it may continue its current, limited experimental testing without disruption and adequately plan for its modified system design.
