Frequency Tolerance

In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth in the underlying application.

Interference Avoidance

Applicant shall take all practicable steps to avoid interference to Radio Astronomy Services in the 1395-1400 MHz band.

Coordination

Applicant will coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers frequency coordinator and the Fixed Microwave Service licensees prior to operation in the 2450-2483 MHz band.

Emissions

Applicant will ensure that no emissions extend into the 1400-1427 MHz band in order to protect the Radio Astronomy Services.

De-Conflict

Applicant will schedule and de-conflict with the WAFC prior to operations in the WAFC AOR. Jamie Heaton, CIV, DOD Western Area Frequency Coordinator, Comm: 760-939-6832, DSN: 437-6832.

Airborne Operations

Airborne operations shall direct their radiation towards the ground station at all times. Airborne radiation shall not occur during level flight. At no time will the aircraft radiate during banking.
