**SUPPLEMENTAL STATEMENT REGARDING
REQUEST FOR MARKET STUDY AUTHORIZATION**

In conjunction with its request to obtain an experimental license to use channels at 71.00-72.75 GHz, 73.00-74.75 GHz, 92.1-93.0 GHz, and 94.1-95.0 GHz, and, pursuant to Section 5.3(j) and 5.93 of the Commission's Rules, Applicant requests that it be authorized to conduct limited market studies while to test its technology using the above-mentioned spectrum.

As noted in the Narrative Statement to this Application, Applicant initially intends to conduct limited market studies at two resort hotels in the Hawaiian Islands. In the limited market trial, Applicant wishes to establish that its millimeter wave technology in the bands specified above could be used for wireless transit broadband transmissions.

In conjunction with services not directly related to this request for experimental license, Applicant will provide on a commercial basis computer networking and data services to these hotels. Although it is anticipated that the cost of the trials will be funded in part by the Applicant, the hotels, and possibly the local tourist bureau, it is not the Applicant's intention to realize profits from the requested limited market study. To further clarify this point, the public (i.e., end-user guests at the hotels) will not be charged for experimental wireless services provided as part of the limited market study.

During the term of the requested experimental license, the Applicant intends to identify additional opportunities for limited market study trials for private sector wireless data communications. Like the Hawaiian studies, Applicant will does not intend to profit from such market trials or charge the public for the limited market trials.
