Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) The authorized station herein must not be used for air traffic control communications.
- (4) Aircraft operations are limited to U.S.-registered aircraft.
- (5) The authorized station must be in compliance with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requirements as set forth in Section 17.4 of the Commission's Rules.
- (6) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.

Special Conditions:

- (7) Operations are on a non-interference basis (NIB) and shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference and notify the FCC in writing.
- (8) The applicant must obtain consents from the Advance Wireless Service licensees prior to operation in 2110-2199 MHz band.
- (9) Operation is subject to coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers frequency coordinator prior to operation in 2025-2110 MHz and 2450-2480 MHz bands.
- (10) Operation is subject to coordinate with the affected Fixed Microwave Service licensees prior to operation in 2450-2480 MHz band.
- (11) Operation is NOT PERMITTED using the frequency 2290-2300 MHz.
