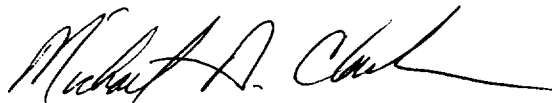
Request for Special Temporary Authority

Dear Sir or Madam:

On July 15, 1998, Triton Network Systems, Inc. ("Triton") filed an application on FCC Form 442 (copy enclosed) for a new experimental authorization. The Commission has not yet acted on this application, and Triton urgently needs to commence operation. Accordingly, Triton hereby requests Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to operate in the manner described in its application.
