Jose,

Operations conducted will support pre-tests and demonstration of an experimental navigation and tracking system with remote monitoring capability as required by the contract referenced. The system utilizes a first responder radio with data capability (Motorola XTS 5000) to transmit remote user location data to a central incident command station.

Two demonstrations are currently planned for May 10, 2011, and May 16, 2011. Pretests will be performed to verify system functionality for several days leading up to each of the two demonstrations. Average test duration will be less than 30 minutes.

The demonstrations will include a total of four transmitting devices; three mobile and one fixed. The fixed transmitter will be connected to the incident command station and receive packets containing location data from three mobile users that will traverse a path in an office building.
