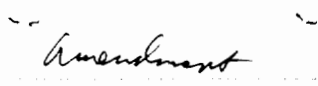

Carl, I am assisting Turner Broadcasting with the experimental license application they filed. Bob Shukai, received a call (from you I think) that Turner needs to submit an exhibit on frequency coordination for their license application. I apologize for the absence of this information, I didn't realize we needed to provide it. However, we certainly can. Prior to filing the application we did a license search through the FCC's site. We identified two or three licensees in the bands within the 80km range of Turner's proposed operations. Turner proposes to operate at such a low power level Turner that our engineers believe it is very unlikely that Turner's operation would cause any harmful interference to them. Can you give me some feedback on what the Exhibit should that look like and what you would like it to contain (and/or reference to the applicable reg)? Do we just need to point out who those license holders are or do we have to make any contact with ? Thanks in advance for your help on this. A
