Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) The designated point-of-contact to terminate transmissions if interference occurs is Mr. Derek Lilla at 612-600-3399.
- (4) Operation is NOT permitted on the frequency band 1525 - 1660 MHz band due to potential harmful interference to GPS L1 operations.
- (5) Operation is NOT permitted on the frequency band 1670 - 1700 MHz band due to potential harmful interference to government weather operations.
- (6) Licensee must coordinate with the Aerospace & Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council (AFTRCC), the telephone number is (770) 494-2893.
- (7) Licensee should get consent from existing and future Advance Wireless Services licensees and from Broadband Radio Service/Educational Broadband Service (BRS/EBS).
