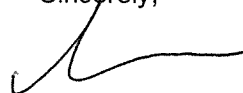
Dear Joe Allman,

This refers to application, File No. 0987-EX-ST-2016, for an experimental authorization.

You are advised that the Commission is unable to grant your application for the facilities requested. In accordance with note G2 of the Table of Allocations, the band 420 MHz – 450 MHz is allocated for federal radiolocation service and is limited to the military services. A military sponsor is required for the use of the 420-450 MHz band. Furthermore, the band 410 – 420 MHz is allocated to fixed, mobile, and space research. The emission bandwidth is such that, in the band 401 – 420 MHz, numerous land mobile radio station will experience interference. Operations affected, include but may not be limited to, emergency communication of first responders, airport security, and search and rescue operations.
