Universal Avionics Systems Corporation, FRN 0019471663, Form 442 File Number 0097-EX-PL-2010 and Confirmation Number EL482804, will conduct Flight Test of the UniLink Communications Management Unit (UL-801), VHF Data Radio (VDR).

Request for Nationwide Authority

Flight test is typically conducted on two company owned King Air test and demonstration platform aircraft. These aircraft operate within the Continental United States.

Initially, flight test will be conducted strictly within the state of Arizona. Eventually, to test operability of the ACARS and VDL2 VDR in areas having greater communication system density, this area of operation may be expanded to, first, neighboring states then later, possibly, to states between Tucson, AZ and Seattle, WA.

Universal Avionics Systems Corporation bases our test aircraft at the airport in Tucson (KTUS), Tucson International Airport and occasionally conducts flights to our Research and Development facility located near Seattle, WA (KBFI), Boeing Field/King County International Airport.
