Dear Mr. Mishra:

The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Commercial Remote Sensing Regulatory Affairs (CRSRA) office has determined under 15 CFR § 960.5(c) that the Multiview Onboard Computational Imager (MOCI) license application, received January 20, 2021 is complete. Under 15 CFR § 960.7, CRSRA will notify you by April 20, 2021, 60 calendar days from the date of this letter, whether the license is granted or denied. If CRSRA has not notified you of a final determination within 60 days of the date of this letter, you may submit a request for the license to be granted within three days, and if CRSRA does not make a final determination in that timeline, you may appeal under 15 CFR § 960.18(a)(3).

If any information you submitted in the license application becomes inaccurate or incomplete at any time between the date of this letter and before the license is granted or denied, you must submit the correct or updated information to CRSRA. Failure to correct such inaccurate or incomplete information violates 15 CFR § 960.16(c). If CRSRA determines that the change is significant to the application, CRSRA will notify you within seven days of receipt of the correct information that the application is deemed to have been withdrawn under 15 CFR § 960.5(d). You may then resubmit the license application with accurate or complete information.
