Special Conditions:

- (1) Operation in the 824-849 or 869-894 MHz band requires consent of local cellular licensee(s) to avoid interference.
- (2) Licensee is required to coordinate operations with existing microwave users in the area to avoid interference.
- (3) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE) frequency coordinator. Consult the list at http://freq.sbe.org/pdf_files/coordinators.pdf to find the appropriate coordinator.
- (4) Licensee must obtain the consent of commercial air-ground licensees in the 849-851MHz/894-896 MHz bands operating within 80 km of the test area.
- (5) Licensee must obtain the consent of SMR licensees in the 896-901MHz/935-940 MHz bands operating within 80 km of the test area.
- (6) Licensee must notify narrowband PCS licensees in the 901-902 MHz band operating within 80 km of the test area.
- (7) Licensee must notify narrowband Location & Monitoring Service licensees in the 902-928 MHz band operating within 80 km of the test area.
