We have a COA through the FAA to operate up to 2500 feet AGL at the location on the application.

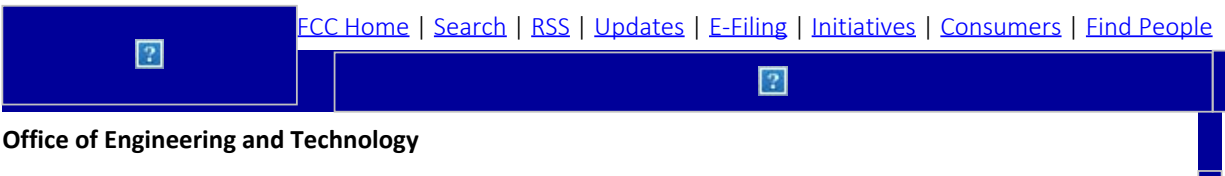
