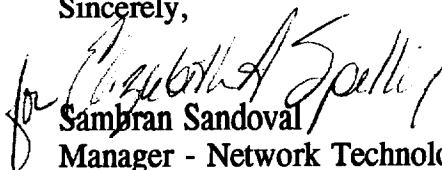
1. Increase the trial area radius from 1 mile to 3 miles.

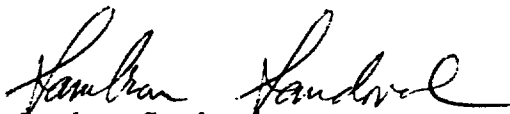
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
