- (3) The applicant must obtain consents from the Advance Wireless Service licensees prior to accessing to 2120-2170 MHz band.
- (4) The applicant must coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers frequency coordinator and the affected Fixed Microwave Service licensees in accordance with 47 C.F.R, Part 101.103(d) prior to operation in 925-960 MHz band.
- (5) Operations is subject to consent of the following licensees within 50 miles of the contours of the testing area:
