VIA-RF, Inc.; Request for Special Temporary Authority for Use of Certain 2.3
and 2.4 GHz frequencies; World Golf Championship (September 12 through
September 16, 2001).

Gentlemen:

This request for STA is made on behalf of our client, **VIA-RF, Inc.**, a provider of video transmission services and remote video and film production at sporting events.

Special temporary authorization is hereby requested for use of certain microwave frequencies between 2.39 and 2.45 GHz for short distance video transmission, at the World Golf Championship at St. Louis, Missouri from September 12 through September 16, 2001. The coordinates for the site are N 38-39-58, W 90-29-00. The coordination with amateur radio service users is pending by this office, through a recognized volunteer amateur radio coordination group in St. Louis, and through the American Radio Relay League, Inc. ("ARRL"). Confirmation of coordination with ARRL will be received soon and understand that confirmation of advance coordination is a pre-condition to this STA.

The frequencies and power levels are as follows:

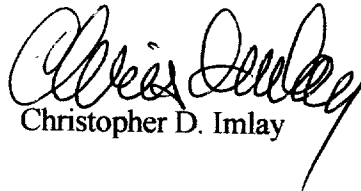
The video transmitters are TVT-50 units. The camera/transmitters will be installed around the golf course. VIA-RF will charge fees for the video production services performed.
