This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Special Conditions:

- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) At least one of the following stop buzzer personnel must be available at all times during all phases of transmissions: Dean Sumi (Vista Research) (562) 900-0615, Chuck Finley (Vista Research) (805) 208-5359, Angela Putney (Vista Research) (703) 920-2100, Watch Supervisor (MXSOCAL) (310) 832-6411 and Reid Crispino (MXSOCAL) (310) 869-8631.
- (4) Vista Research must coordinate with the Western Area Frequency Coordinator (WAFC), Mr. J. Szelog at (760) 939-6948 prior to any California operations to mitigate harmful interference to Navy and Marine Corps assignments. Vista Research must also comply with any and all restrictions that may be levied by WAFC.
- (5) Vista Research must restrict the radar transmission to sectors 250 through 270.
