

REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

As discussed in the accompanying “Narrative Statement,” Walt Disney Imagineering Research & Development, Inc. (“Disney”) seeks experimental special temporary authority (“STA”) to conduct proof-of-concept testing of ultra-wideband equipment authorized under FCC ID: NUF-P440-A for operation under Section 15.519 of the FCC’s Rules, Id. at § 15.519. The experimental authority requested therein will allow the company to assess the capability of ultra-wideband technologies to support radiolocation requirements needed at its premises in Anaheim, California.

A critical objective of the proposed experimentation is to evaluate the functionality and performance of the devices during a period when there is an increased number of individuals within a limited geographic area. The test location specified in the STA experiences a temporary increase in the number of individuals during the requested test dates. Thus, grant of the STA on an expedited basis will allow the company to commence testing on a timely basis so that it may obtain statistically valid, representative data needed for its proof-of-concept analysis. Accordingly, Disney respectfully requests expedited treatment of its request for STA so that it may commence its experimentation on or before **July 20, 2017**.

Also, please note that Disney does not propose to market, sell, or lease prototype equipment to end users. Moreover, no fees will be charged to entities evaluating the equipment during the demonstrations. After the experimentation ceases, Disney will recall and recover all devices that have not received equipment authorization or approval.

PUBLIC INTEREST STATEMENT

Disney submits that issuance of experimental authority is in the public interest, convenience, and necessity. Grant of this application will permit Disney to conduct proof-of-concept testing of equipment needed to support its internal requirements for radiolocation capabilities.
