Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee is required to file a PROGRESS REPORT every 12 months from the date of grant. This progress report shall be filed with Federal Communications Commission; Experimental Licensing Branch, MS 1300E1; 445 12 Street, S.W.; Washington, DC 20554.
- (2) Prior to equipment authorization or a determination of compliance, the device must be accompanied by a conspicuous notice worded as follows: "This device has not been authorized as required by the rules of the Federal Communications Commission. This device is not, and may not be, offered for sale or lease, or sold or leased, until authorization is obtained."
- (3) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (4) All transmitting and/or receiving equipment used in the study shall be owned by the licensee.
- (5) Licensee is required to ensure that trial devices are either rendered inoperable or retrieved by them from trial participants at the conclusion of the trial. Licensee is required to notify trial participants in advance that operation of the trial device is subject to this condition.
- (6) The occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (7) Licensee shall coordinate operations with the appropriate frequency coordinator or all of the public safety licensees using the frequencies in question in the proposed area of operation.
