This refers to application, File No. 0234-EX-ST-2006, for Experimental Radio Station .

The enclosed authorization shall be considered as a grant of the referenced application unless rejected by a written notice within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter, whereupon the enclosed grant will be vacated. Such rejection should include a statement of the reasons, if any, why the applicant believes that the application should be granted in accordance with the terms requested therein.

You are advised that the Commission was unable to make a finding that the public interest would be served by a grant of the application in the manner requested. The requested frequency range of 10 kHz to 10 MHz is beyond the typical bands that have been previously approved for RF Immunity testing. It is too difficult to coordinate this broad range to ensure that testing will not cause interference to the numerous authorized services.
