>> This communications system will be used to test and evaluate the operation and features of wireless devices used by the Intelligence & Information Warfare Directorate (I2WD) of the US Army Communications Electronics Research, Development, and Engineering Center (CERDEC). The system is used for transmission and reception of voice and data within the standalone network boundary and does not interconnect to any other provider's network. The system will interface wirelessly with mobile user devices. It will also interface with remote core system controllers through an optical interface. All these systems are located within the US Army locations.
