In accordance with special condition No. 2 on your experimental license, you are required to file a progress report with the FCC every three months. The license was granted with an effective date of March 17, 1992; therefore, the first report was due June 17, 1992. The FCC records indicate that no reports have been filed in regard to this station.

Licensee shall file a progress report as required by the experimental license, within 30 days from the date of this letter. In accordance with Section 5.60(b) of the FCC Rules, failure to respond to official correspondence or request for additional information will be cause for dismissal.

Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee is authorized to use various modes of modulation, bandwidth, and data rates. None of these modes of transmission shall extend beyond the band limits set forth above. Power and emission for the 902-928, 2400-2483.5 and 5725-5850 MHZ bands must conform to Part 15 FCC Rules.
- (2) The licensee is required to file a progress report with the FCC every three months to include the types of emissions used and technical findings. The report should be filed with FCC, Frequency Liaison Branch, Room 7326, Washington, DC 20554.
- (3) The station identification requirements of Section 5.152 of the FCC rules are waived.
- (4) Licensee should be aware that other station may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (5) After coordination with microwave licensees, the licensee shall inform the Commission of the specific sites selected for test transmissions.
- (6) The License shall inform the Commission immediately of any interference complaints from any authorized users of the band at any stage of system development.
