I seem to be having difficulty in sending my narrative statement electronically on your Add Attachments page. The narrative statement is as follows:

Our research purpose is to collect motor vehicle speed data on residential street(s) in the Town of Purcellville using a FCC Type Accepted - Kustom HR 12 K Band Hand Held Radar Gun. This data will be analyzed to determine if a speed limit change would be warranted and/or traffic calming (speed humps) would be justified. Results will be shared with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT). This monitoring will be conducted in a manner that will be transparent (to minimize the influence of artificial speed compliance behavior) to the motorist in order to insure the speed data collected reflects actual speed behavior. Research operations will be intermittent, 24hrs/day, 7 days/wk and will be conducted in both mobile and fixed modes.
