Wireless Broadband Systems hereby requests expedited treatment of this application for experimental authorization. Specifically, Wireless Broadband Systems asserts that expedited action by the Commission is necessary to ensure that Wireless Broadband Systems proposed experimental services may be deployed without delay and as soon as possible and that a substantial portion of its trial is completed prior to the adoption of any changes proposed during the reconsiderations by the Commissions for the possible use of unlicensed devices in the 5.4 GHz band.

Wireless Broadband Systems has already placed orders for the purchase of the equipment described in this application, and is prepared to immediately execute leases on buildings and rooftops necessary to commence experimental operation. As a result, a lengthy processing delay would not only be detrimental to Wireless Broadband Systems proposed experimental operation, but would also harm the public. As explained in the instant application, Wireless Broadband Systems seeks to demonstrate, through experimental operation, that the 5.4 GHz band is suitable for operation of unlicensed devices, both inside and outside areas which could be deemed “precluded” by the rules of the proposed by the FCC. Because the Commission is currently seeking public inquiry on use of the 5.4 GHz band, time is of the essence to ensure that Wireless Broadband Systems may immediately commence its experimental operation and have time to report back to the FCC on its findings prior to final establishment of rules relating to the 5.4 GHz band. Accordingly, an expedited grant of the instant application is necessary and in the public interest.
