Re: Request for Special Temporary Authority for Use of Certain frequencies at 1.7/1.8 GHz, 2.3/2.4 GHz, and 4.5 GHz; WIRELESS VIDEO, INC. (Millersville, MD); Winter Haven, FL event Nov. 1 through Nov. 7, 1999; Request for Special Temporary Authorization.

Gentlemen:

This request for Special Temporary Authority is made on behalf of our client, Wireless Video, Inc., a manufacturer and provider of video transmission equipment for remote video and film production. Special temporary authorization is hereby requested for operation at a fishing tournament on Nov. 1 through Nov. 7, 1999 in Winter Haven, FL for use at the frequencies and power levels listed in EXHIBIT A, attached herewith. Operation under this STA will be conditioned on coordination with the Aeronautical Flight Test Telemetry Council (AFTRCC). Furthermore, all operation will be on a non-interference basis to licensed users of these frequencies.

Wireless Video intends to use 10 RF cameras for video relay during the event. Because of the path lengths involved, four repeater boats will be used to relay video from cameras to a production trunk on shore. The antenna gain will be 12 dbi using spiral or horn type antennas.

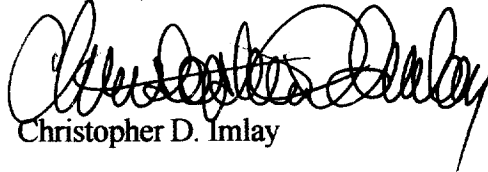
