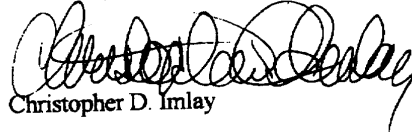

have requested evidence of AFTRCC Coordination. Coordination
approval from AFTRCC relative to the Pasadena, CA event is
attached.

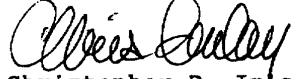
As to the New York event, AFTRCC coordinators were unavailable
due to the Christmas holidays and did not, prior to their
departure, confirm the coordination applied for by our client.
However, our client has coordinated the use of the 2367 and 2384
MHz channels with Mr. Joseph Nuzzo of ABC Network, which has
already received AFTRCC approval for the use of those two channels
and has obtained, presumably from your office, Special Temporary
Authority for the use of those two channels at the same time at the
same location. There can be no doubt that the use of those channels
in Times Square during New Years' Eve is fully and completely
coordinated with AFTRCC.
