The subject radar, a commercially manufactured Western Electric Co. Model SJ-1, is original equipment aboard the USS COBIA (SS 245) a Gato class Fleet submarine launched by the Electric Boat Company on November 28, 1943.

This boat served during WWII in the Pacific compiling a meritorious record during her six war patrols . COBIA has been declared a National Monument and is now on loan from the US Navy to the Wisconsin Maritime Museum, a 501c3 corporation. It is used as an educational artifact. The Museum has successfully restored to operation all of the boats' other radio equipment and is now beginning work on her radars.

These restoration efforts have two primary goals: 1) Preservation of the National Monument, and, 2) Serving as an educational platform for future generations.
