Re: Extension of Test Agreement with MCLM DIP for AMTS License Spectrum

Dear Mr. Brunner:

This letter evidences the extension of that test agreement between Wisconsin Public Service Corporation ("WPSC") and Maritime Communications/Land Mobile, LLC as Debtor-in-Possession ("MCLM DIP"), dated October 3, 2013.

In accordance with Section 2.803(e)(3)(iii) of the FCC's rules, MCLM DIP as the Licensee hereby provides WPSC permission to operate radio devices using its AMTS frequencies ranging from 217.5 MHz - 218.0 MHz and 219.5 MHz - 220.0 MHz band for testing and demonstration purposes. The tests will be performed in the State of Michigan in Gogebic County and in the State of Wisconsin in Vilas, Lincoln, Oneida, Forest, Florence, Marinette, Oconto, Menominee, and Langlade counties with a lab testing area in Brown County.

WPSC will have the ability to transmit and receive at an AGL up to 300 ft. In addition, WPSC will operate with output up to 40 watts at maximum AGL.

This letter permits WPSC to continue operations from June 30, 2014 through December 31, 2014. WPSC will need to obtain our permission to extend the tests beyond this term, such extension will be upon similar terms and conditions.

WPSC shall not cause interference to any authorized user and must accept any interference caused by existing systems. The License Holder may terminate this Letter of Authorization at any time for any reason, without recourse, in the event of interference or perceived interference to third parties. However, should License Holder exercise its right to terminate this Letter of Authorization, License holder shall refund WPSC a pro rata

share of the \$6,000 referenced below based on the number of months remaining for testing at the time of termination.

While the License Holder remains responsible for compliance with all of the operating conditions and requirements associated with this license, this temporary authorization is expressly conditioned on all operations by WPSC being conducted in accordance with the FCC's rules. In particular, we note that WPSC is responsible for ensuring compliance with the provisions of Part 17 of the FCC's rules regarding FAA antenna tower registration and antenna tower lighting and marking requirements, if applicable.

Our permission is also expressly conditioned on WPSC undertaking to: the extent of WPSC's negligence, indemnify, defend and hold harmless the License Holder and its affiliates from and against any and all claims or liabilities of any nature whatsoever (including reasonable attorney's fees) directly arising out of or in connection with these testing operations, including but not limited to any breach by WPSC of its obligations under this authorization, or which may arise out of any defect, malfunction or failure to function of any device operated or supplied by WPSC, or arising out of any installation activities performed by WPSC personnel or contractors.

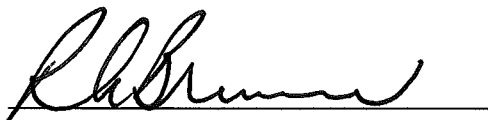
In exchange for permission to test these channels during this time frame, WPSC agrees to pay MCLM DIP Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) on or before May 1, 2014. As we discussed, MCLM DIP will not credit this amount toward the purchase price of spectrum in any future agreement and reserves the right to sell or lease the spectrum to a third party effective at the end of the test period.

In addition, MCLM DIP may send an authorized representative to visit with WPSC in Green Bay or at the test location in order to verify proper operation of the testing system. The reasonable cost of such travel, including airfare from Washington, DC, and hotel for one night, will be provided by WPSC.
