The request from SB : To move forward with any earth station authorization, it's essential that the space station involved is officially authorized by the U.S. Since this isn't the case for the LS-4 spacecraft, we'll need to follow the requirements set out in 47 CFR 5.64(b). It's important that the applicant provides all the information outlined in that section so we can properly review their request. Along with the details required under 47 CFR 5.64(b), we'll also like to see the relevant ITU filings, information about the country that registered the LS-4 space object with the United Nations, and documentation confirming authorization for the requested operations in this filing. Once all of this material is submitted, we'll be able to proceed with the review process.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of April 07, 2026 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
