

This is a multi-function 4K UHD camcorder, which has the function of photo and video. It supports WiFi wireless application and has the following features:




If the configuration of computer is quite low, camcorder may not work properly or get stuck when connecting to computer.





1.3 Functions of keys

Icon	Key name	Function description
POWER/ LIGHT	【POWER/LIGHT】	Short press to power on the camera; After powering on, long press for 2 seconds to power off the camera; short press to turn on/off IR light.
MENU	[MENU]	Pop-up menu/Back to the previous menu/Exit menu.
DISP/WIFI	[DISP/WIFI]	Short press to switch screen display: Display icon, close icon, close screen. In photo/video mode: Long press for 2 seconds to turn WiFi on/off.
	[РНОТО]	In photo mode, press it lightly for focus, press it heavily to take photo. In video mode, during recording video, press it heavily to pause/ continue video. In playback mode: press it again to pause/play.
MODE	[MODE]	Switch working mode: Video mode/Photo mode/Playback mode.
	[W/T]	In Photo/video mode: Zoom in/out. In video playback: Turn up/down the volume. In playback mode: Page forward/backward. In the menu: Select forward/backward.


In this manual, places with [] represent keys or switches, such as [MENU] represents MENU key.

2.1Installation of the memory card


This machine needs to install the memory card, please follow the instructions.

- 2.1.10pen the memory card cover.
- 2.1.2 Insert the memory card in the direction shown and push it inward until you hear a click.
- 2.1.3 Close the memory card cover.

Open the SD card cover according to the direction of arrow



Insert the SD card according the direction of arrow



Notice:

Please use a regular brand of Class 6 or above memory card.

Do not insert or remove the memory card during work, which may damage the memory card or lose data! Some memory cards may cause the unit to crash or work improperly.

If the "Card is Full" is displayed, Indicates that the card is full. Replace the memory card or delete the file.

2.2 Installation of battery

This machine uses external battery, please refer to the picture to install.

- 2.2.1 Install the battery with the metal contact of the battery facing upwards.
- 2.2.2 Follow the arrow direction on battery compartment, push the battery until a "Click" is sounded which means the installation is complete.

1.Install battery into the battery compartment according to this direction.



Notice:

Please install battery correctly, incorrect installation will not boot or damage the camcorder, and may cause accidents!

2.3Charge the battery

- 2.3.1 Install the battery, connect the unit and charger with USB cable to the mains. The indicator "CHG" lights up indicating the battery is being charged, and the indicator lights off after the battery is charged.
- 2.3.2 Connect the computer to charge the unit. Connect the unit to the computer with a USB cable. The indicator "CHG" lights up indicating the battery is being charged, and the indicator lights off after the battery is charged.
- $2.3.3\ Charger\ specifications:\ Input\ AC100\sim240V/50\sim60HZ,\ Output\ DC\ 5V/15A,\ please\ confirm\ the\ charger\ and power\ supply\ specifications.$
- 2.3.4 In order to adapt to long time shooting, the unit can be charged while shooting. To use this function, please use the tripod to fix the unit, and follow the steps of 2.3.1 to open the unit.

Notice:Please confirm local power specifications! Keep ventilation during charging, no covering. After charging, remove the power asap!

When using computer USB to charge the unit, please turn off the unit, otherwise the computer may be damaged!

Power on and power off the camcorder

- 1.Short press [Power/IR LIGHT] to power on the camcorder;
- 2. Long press [Power/IR LIGHT] to power off the camcorder;
- 3. Open the screen and the machine will start up automatically. Close the screen, automatic shutdown.
- 4. The camcorder support the function of auto power-off. When not in use for a period of time, the unit automatically shut down to save power.

2. 5 Switching working Mode

To switch the working mode of the machine, press [MODE] to pop up the "MODE Selection" menu. Press [W/T] to select the mode and press [Photo] to enter the selected mode.

2.5.1 Video mode

This machine supports ordinary video, slow photography, cyclic video, time-lapse video and other modes. Ordinary video: The icon is displayed in the upper left corner of the screen, indicating it's recording a common video. Slow photography: The icon is displayed in the upper left corner of the screen, indicating it's recording a slow motion. Cyclic video: The icon is displayed in the upper left corner of the screen, indicating it's recording cyclic video automatically. Time-lapse video: The icon is displayed in the upper left corner of the screen, indicating it's recording time-lapse video.

In video mode, press 【VIDEO】 to record video, and press 【VIDEO】 again to stop shooting.

2.5.2 Photo mode

This machine supports ordinary photo, automatic photo, continuous photo, timing photo mode.

Ordinary photo: The icon ois displayed in the upper left corner of the screen, press [PHOTO] to take common photos. Automatic photo: The icon ois displayed in the upper left corner of the screen, press [PHOTO] to automatically take photos at regular intervals.

Continuous photo: The icon is displayed in the upper left corner of the screen, press [PHOTO] to take 3 photos in succession. Timing photo: The icon is displayed in the upper left corner of the screen, press [PHOTO] to take photos after a certain time.

2.5.3 Playback mode

View photos or videos and perform related operations.

2.6 Instructions of remote control

The machine can be operated by remote control, and the key functions of the remote control are as follows:



Please take off the battery protective slice before use.

Icon	Function description
0	In photo mode: Take photo; In video mode: Pause/continue recording.
REC	In video mode: Start/stop video
30%	In photo/video mode: Turn on/off IR light; In the menu: Select up
MENU	Bring up the menu/back to the previous menu/exit the menu.

MODE	Switch working mode; In setup menu: To switch the menu.
•	In menu mode: Select down.
0	In photo/video mode: Zoom in the picture.

Notice:

Before use remote control please take off the battery protective slice. When use remote control, please aim at the remote receive window of camcorder, objects can not be shielded in the middle.

2.7Connect to PC


The unit can be connected to the computer using USB cable. After connected, it can be charged, transferred files or used as a camcorder.

After the connection is successful according to the figure, the screen displays options: charging mode, large-capacity storage mode, camcorder mode.

Select charging mode to charge the unit only.

Select the large-capacity storage mode, which can be used like a USB flash drive.

Select camcorder mode and use it as a computer camcorder.




Notice:

Because of the computer system, if you select camcorder mode, download the required software.

2.8 Connected TV

The unit can be connected to the TV.


- 2.8.1 Use HDMI cable to connect the unit to the HD port of the TV.
- 2.8.2Switch the signal input of the TV set to a port connected to the unit.
- 2.8.3 Turn on the unit, normal operation, all contents will be displayed on the TV.



2.9 Use external microphone (optional accessory)

Using external microphone can effectively improve sound quality, and get good recording effect.

- 2.9. TRead the technical specifications and instructions of the external microphone carefully to avoid damaging the device.
- 2.9.2Install the external microphone as shown and lock the nut.
- 2.9.3 Insert the microphone 3.5mm coaxial plug into the MIC interface of the machine and turn on the microphone switch



Insert the 3.5mm coaxial plug into the microphone

Notice:

Adaptable external microphone parameters: output impedance $0.2K\Omega$ - $2.2K\Omega$, 3.5mm coaxial port. After the external mic is connected, the host automatically switches to an external mic. Because each external microphone parameter is different, the specific effect is selected after actual adaptation.

2.10 Use zoom function

This machine has the digital zoom function, in the video/photo mode, toggle [W/T] rightward to bring the object closer (enlarge the scene), toggle [W/T] leftward to pull away from the object (shrink the object).

2.11Use night vision function

This machine has infrared night vision function, can shoot black and white photos and videos in the dark environment.

In Photo/Video mode: short press [Power/LIGHT] to enable night vision, short press [Power/LED] again to turn off the IR light.

Notice:

Night vision can only be turned on or off in camcorder mode or video mode.


3Use the camcorder

This chapter helps you understand how to use the various advanced features of the camera.

3.1 Video Mode

In video mode, the screen displays relevant icons with the following meanings:

1Video mode indicator	2Recording time indicator	3Memory card indicator	4Battery capacity indicator
5 Zoom indicator	6 Menu icon	7 Date time indicator	8Resolution indicator
9 Playback icon	10 Exposure indicator		



3.1.1Video Recordina

Install the memory card and battery, short press <code>[POWER/LIGHT]</code> to start up and enter the recording mode. Focus the camera on the object, press the <code>[Video]</code> to start recording, and press <code>[Video]</code> again to stop recording. During recording, the red icon in the upper left corner of the screen continues flashing.

In the video mode, users can set various parameters to help take a more beautiful picture. If you are not familiar with the machine, you can use the default settings. The following settings are performed in video mode.

3.1.2Resolution

Set the video resolution. The higher the resolution, the better the clarity, but the bigger the file.

- 3.1.2.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Resolution", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu;
- 3.1.2.2 Press [W/T] to select desired resolution:
- 4K P60/4K P30/2.7K P30/FHD P60/FHD P30/HD P60/HD P30;
- 3.1.2.3 Press [PHOTO] to save, press [Menu] again to back to video mode.

This function supports touch screen operation:

A Click the "MENU" icon in the lower right corner of the screen to enter the setting menu, click the "Video resolution" icon to pop up the resolution option.


B Click desired resolution to back to previous menu.

C Click the back icon ' to return to the video mode.

The following functions in this section support touch operations. The usage method is the same as 3.12.







3.1.3 Electronic anti-shake

Turn on or off the electronic anti-shake function. Enable this function to reduce the blur caused by shake.

- 3.1.3.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Electronic anti-shake", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu;
- 3.1.3.2 Press [W/T] to select desired option:On/Off;
- 3.1.3.3 Press [PHOTO] to save, press [Menu] again to back to video mode...
- 3.1.4 White balance

Adjust the color deviation of the picture according to the light source environment.

Automatic mode is recommended.

- 3.1.3.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "White balance", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu;
- 3.1.3.2 Press [W/T] to select desired option: Auto / Daylight / Cloudy / Tungsten / Fluorescence
- 3.1.3.3Press [PHOTO] to save, press [Menu] again to back to video mode...
- 3.1.5Exposure

Adjust exposure value (EV) according to the environment. The higher the EV, the brighter the video, and the smaller the EV, the darker the video.

- 3.1.5.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Exposure", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu;
- 3.1.3.2 Press [W/T] to select desired value of exposure: -3/-2/-1/0/+1/+2/+3;
- 3.1.3.3 Press [PHOTO] to save, press [Menu] again to back to video mode.

Notice: This function is invalid when ambient brightness is low.

3.1.6 Metering mode

Set metering mode when recording.

- 3.1.5.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Metering mode", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu;
- 3.1.3.2 Press [W/T] to select desired option: Average metering/central key metering/point metering/matrix testing;
- 3.1.3.3 Press [PHOTO] to save, press [Menu] again to back to video mode.

3.1.7Sharpness

Adjust the sharpness of the video to make the edges clearer or softer.

- 3.1.7.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Sharpness", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu;
- 3.1.7.2 Press [W/T] to select desired option: High/Middle/Low;
- 3.1.7.3Press [PHOTO] to save, press [Menu] again to back to video mode.
- 3.1.8 Video Quality

Adjust the quality of the video.

- 3.1.8.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Video Quality", press [PHOTO] to enter Into the sub-menu;
- 3.1.8.2 Press [W/T] to select desired option: High/Middle/Low;
- 3.1.8.3 Press [PHOTO] to save, press [Menu] again to back to video mode.
- 3.1.9Sensitivity

Adjust video sensitivity (ISO), automatic mode is recommended;

- 3.1.9.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Sensitivity", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu:
- 3.1.9.2 Press [W/T] to select desired option: Auto/100/200/400/800/1600/3200/6400
- 3.1.9.3 Press [PHOTO] to save, press [Menu] again to back to video mode.
- 3.1.10 Time watermark

Sets whether the time and date are displayed on the video

- 3.1.10.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Time watermark".
- 3.1.10.2 Press [PHOTO] to select: Turn on/turn off, press [Menu] to back.
- 3.1.11 Record Audio


Set whether to record sound at the same time when recording a video.

- 3.1.11.1Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "recording Audio".
- 3.1.11.2 Press [PHOTO] to select: Turn on/turn off, press [Menu] to back.

3.2 Photo mode

In photo mode, relevant icons are displayed on the screen with the following meanings:

1Photo mode indicator	2Memory card indicator	3Battery capacity indicator	4Zoom indicator
5 MENU touchable icon	6Date time indicator	7Resolution icon	8Playback icon
9 EV indicator			



3.2.1Take Photo

Boot into the video mode, press [MODE] to enter the mode option, select "ordinary photo", press the [PHOTO] to enter the ordinary photo.

Focus the lens on the subject, adjust the angle and bearing, grip and hold steady. Tap 【PHOTO】 to pop up a focus frame. Keep pressing 【PHOTO】 down to the button, the photo will be taken until "click" is sounded.

In photo mode you can set various parameters to help you get better photos. If you're not familiar with the camera, you can also use the camera's default settings.

The following settings are carried out in photo mode.

3.2.2 Resolution

Set the photo resolution. The higher the resolution the larger the size of the photo, the more storage space it takes up.

- 3.1.2 In photo mode, press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Resolution", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu;
- 3.1.2.2 Press [W/T] to select desired resolution:48M、36M、24M、20M、16M、12M、8M、5M;
- 3.1.2.3 Press [PHOTO] to save, press [Menu] again to back to video mode.

This function supports touch screen operation:

A In photo mode, click the "MENU" icon in the lower right corner of the screen to enter the setting menu, click the "photo resolution" icon to pop up the resolution option: 48M, 36M, 24M, 20M, 16M, 12M, 8M, 5M

B Drag options and click the desired resolution to back to previous menu. C Click the 'D icon to return to the video mode.

The following functions in this section support touch operations. The usage method is the same as 3.12.

3.2.3 White balance

Adjust the color deviation of the photo according to the light source environment. Automatic mode is recommended.

- 3.2.3.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "White balance", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu;
- 3.2.3.2 Press [W/T] to select desired option: Auto / Daylight / Cloudy / Tungsten / Fluorescence
- 3.2.3.3 Press [PHOTO] to save, press [Menu] again to back to photo mode.







3.2.4Exposure

Adjust exposure value (EV) according to the environment. The higher the EV, the brighter the photo. This function is invalid when ambient brightness is low.

- $3.2.4.1 \, \text{Press}$ [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Exposure", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu;
- 3.2.4.2 Press [W/T] to select desired value of exposure: -3/-2/-1/0/+1/+2/+3;
- 3.2.4.3 Press [PHOTO] to save, press [Menu] again to back to photo mode.

3.2.5 Metering mode

Set the metering mode of the camera.

- 3.2.5.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Metering mode", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu;
- 3.2.5.2 Press [W/T] to select desired option: Average metering/central key metering/point metering/matrix testing; 3.2.5.3 Press [PHOTO] to save, press [Menu] again to back to photo mode.

3.2.6Sharpness

Adjust the sharpness of the video to make the edges clearer or softer.

- 3.2.6.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Sharpness", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu;
- 3.2.6.2 Press [W/T] to select desired option: High/Middle/Low;
- 3.2.6.3 Press [PHOTO] to save press [Menu] again to back to photo mode.

3.2.7Sensitivity

Adjust photo sensitivity (ISO), automatic mode is recommended;

- 3.2.7.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Sensitivity", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu;
- 3.2.7.2 Press [W/T] to select desired option: Auto/100/200/400/800/1600/3200/6400
- 3.2.7.3Press [PHOTO] to save, press [Menu] again to back to photo mode.

3.2.8 Time watermark

Sets whether the time and date are displayed on the video

- 3.2.8.1 Press [Menu] to bring up menu options, press [W/T] to select "Time stamp".
- 3.2.8.2 press [PHOTO] to select desired option: Turn on/Turn off
- 3.2.8.3 Press [Menu] to save, and back.

- 3.3 Playback photo or video
- 3.3.1Enter into playback menu

Press [W/T] to turn the page and select files, "Video" icon displayed for video file, "Photo" icon displayed for photo file.

Slect the video file and press [PHOTO] to play, during the play, press [PHOTO] to pause, press [PHOTO] again to continue playing.

During video playback, press [W/T] to adjust the volume. Press [MODE] to exit playback mode. In playback mode, click the " "icon to turn the page. Click the " "icon to play the video. Click the screen during playback to pop up " "icon in the center of screen, Click the icon to pause. Click the " "icon to exit the playback mode.





- 3.3.2 Delete file
- In playback mode, delete the videos or photos.
- 3.3.2.1 Press [W/T] to select the file need to be deleted.
- 3.3.2.2 Press [MENU] to pop the options: Confirm to delete the current file, press [W/T] to select: Confirm/Cancel.
- 3.3.2.3 Press [MENU] to perform the operation, press [MODE] to back to playback mode.

Touch screen operation:

3.4System set


Set system parameters such as language, key tone, light frequency, time and date.

In photo or video mode, press [MENU] to enter the setup menu, press [MODE] to switch to system set menu, and the gear icon in the upper left corner of the screen will be highlighted, indicates that the system set menu is displayed. The following operations are performed in this menu. After setting, press [MENU] to exit system set.

Touch screen operation:

In photo or video mode, click the "MENU" icon in the lower right corner of the screen to enter the setup menu, and click the " * icon to switch to system set.

Click the " "icon on the left side of the screen to exit system set.



3.4.1 Beep set

This function is to set whether the key sound is on.

- $3.4.1 \, \text{ln system set menu, press [W/T] to select "Beep set", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu;} \\$
- 3.4.2 Press 【W/T】 to select the desired operation: High / Middle / Low/Off.
- 3.4.3 Press [PHOTO] to save and back to system set.

Touch screen operation:

 $\label{linear_continuity} Click \, \text{``Beep set''} \, to \, enter \, into \, the \, sub-menu, \, click \, the \, desired \, operation: \, High \, / \, Middle \, / \, Low/Off. \, It \, will \, automatically \, back \, to \, the \, system \, set \, after \, setting.$

The following operations are the same.

3.4.2WiFi

Turn WiFi on or off.

- 3.4.2.1 In system set menu, press [W/T] to select "Wi-Fi".
- 3.4.2.2 Press [PHOTO] to selsct: Turn on /Turn off.
- $3.4.2.3\,After\,the\,option\,is\,enabled,\,wait\,until\,the "Wi-Fi\,information" is\,displayed.\,Then,\,you\,can\,connect\,your\,mobile\,phone\,to\,the\,local\,computer.$

3.4.3 Light Source Frequency

Set the frequency of the local light source to avoid flickering in the lighting environment. For details, see using local power frequency.

- 3.4.3.1 Press [W/T] to select "Light Source Frequency", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu.
- 3.4.3.2 Press [W/T] to selsct: Auto /50Hz/60Hz.
- 3.4.3.3 Press [PHOTO] to save and back to system set.

3.4.4 Timing Off

Set automatic shutdown time of the unit. If not used within a certain period of time, the unit will automatically shut down to save power.

- 3.4.4.1 Press [W/T] to select "Timing Off", press [PHOTO] to enter into the sub-menu.
- 3.4.4.2 Press [W/T] to selsct: Turn off /3minutes/5minutes/10minutes.

3.4.5 Language

According to user requirements, set the operation language of the machine, which is more consistent with user habits.

View the software version of the local machine.

3.4.11 Factory Reset

Use this feature to restore the factory default settings, when incorrect settings prevent the machine from working properly.
