Important Safety Instructions

When using this device, the following basic precautions should be always followed:

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE USING.

- This device is for household use only and is not intended for medical or commercial purposes.
- 2. Children shall not play with the device.
- 3. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children.
- 4. This device can be used by children aged 8 and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or cognitive capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge only if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the device in a safe way and understood the hazards involved.

DANGER – To reduce the risk of electric shock:

- 1. Never use pins or other metallic fasteners with this device.
- Carefully examine the covering before each use. Discard the device if the covering shows any sign of deterioration, such as checking, blistering or cracking.
- 3. Please attach the plug fully for use to avoid unnecessary electric shock or injury.
- Do not operate the device and handle the plug with wet hands or wet feet.
- Do not pour water into the device or immerse the device into water or other liquids.
- Do not place or store the device where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- Do not use or store the device in wet environments (e.g. spa, bathroom, sink) or moist conditions, high temperatures or dusty

- places.
- 8. Do not reach for the device that has fallen into the water. Unplug immediately.

Otherwise, it may cause accidents, injuries or discomfort!

- If you feel any discomfort (such as inflamed skin, redness, itching, etc.), please stop using the device immediately and consult your doctor.
- The device should never be left unattended when plugged in. Unplug from the outlet when not in use or before cleaning, putting on or taking off parts.
- 3. Do not use the device while covered in a quilt or blanket or near heat resources (e.g. radiators or stoves). Excessive heating can occur and

- cause fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- 4. Close supervision is necessary when this device is used by, on, or near children, invalids, or disabled persons.
- 5. Never operate this device if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped or damaged, or dropped into water. Return the device to a service center for examination and repair.
- 6. Do not carry this device by the supply cord or use the cord as a handle. Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- 7. Never operate the device with the air openings blocked. Keep the air openings free of lint, hair, and the like.

- 15. Do not use while sleeping/feeling asleep or after intake of alcohol.
- Any modification or disassembly of the device without authorization is prohibited.
- 17. If a high temperature or foul odor occurs, please stop using the device immediately and unplug it.
- 18. Do not put your feet reversely into the device, otherwise, the malfunction may occur.
- 19. Make sure the massage is complete before removing your feet.
- 20. To disconnect, turn all controls to the off position, then remove the plug from the outlet.
- 21. Only use accessories officially provided by RENPHO.
- 22. The device has a heated surface. Persons insensitive to heat must be careful when using the device.
- 23. Use heated surfaces carefully. May cause serious burns. Do not use it on insensitive skin or on a person with poor blood circulation. The

- unattended use of heat by children or incapacitated persons may be dangerous.
- 24. Temperatures sufficiently high to cause burns may occur regardless of the control setting. Do not use the device on an infant or invalid or on a sleeping or unconscious person. Check the skin in contact with the heated area of the device frequently to reduce the risk of blistering.

3. Product Introduction



Control Panel

(1) Foot Massager



Tap to turn on/off the foot massager only OR both the foot massager and calf massager if they work together.



Tap to cycle through 15 (Default), 20, 25 and 30min.



Tap to cycle through Level 1 (Default), Level 2, Level 3, Level 4 Air Intensity and OFF.



Tap to cycle through Level 1 (Default), Level 2, Level 3, Level 4 and OFF.



Tap to cycle through Full (Default), Bottom, Instep and OFF.



The indicator will be on once the pairing is successful.

(2) Calf Massager





Long press to turn on the calf massager only. Long/short press to turn off the calf massager only.



Short press to turn on/off the heat function (On, default).

Press and hold for 3s to turn on/off the LED light.



Press to cycle intensity level through Light (Default), Medium and High.



Press to cycle through Mode 1 (Default), Mode 2 and Mode 3.



Once the pairing is successful, its indicator will be on.



Charge the calf massager once the lowest battery level indicator flashes.

Remote Control







Press to turn off the calf massager only.



Short press to turn on/off the heat function (On. default).



Press to cycle intensity level through Light (Default), Medium and High.



Press to cycle through Mode 1 (Default), Mode 2 and Mode 3





Press to turn on/off the foot massager only OR both the foot massager and calf massager if they work together.



Press to cycle through Full (Default), Bottom, Instep and OFF.



Press to cycle through Level 1 (Default), Level 2, Level 3, Level 4 and OFF.



Press to cycle through Level 1 (Default), Level 2, Level 3, Level 4 and OFF.



Press to cycle through 15 (Default), 20, 25 and 30min.

Note:

- a. Please remove the isolation strip from the battery when you use the remote control for the first time.
- b. To prolong the battery life, remove the battery from the remote control when not in use for a long time.
- c. The remote control can be magnetically attached to the device when not in use.
- d. The LED light can only be controlled by the Heat button on the control panel of the calf massager.

See the tables below for details of the heat function of the foot massager, and air modes and battery level indicator of the calf massager.

One white light on: battery ≤ 25%

*Once the calf massager is well placed on the charging port on the foot massager and the power cord is connected to the power supply, the calf massager will be charged if not switched on.

Using the Product

1. Recommended Massage Postures









Note:

- a. It is not recommended to use the device for more than 30 minutes each time.
- b. To avoid any injury, do not stand up during the massage.

2. Operation

Work Together (Foot massager+Calf massager)

- (1) Connect the power cord to the power supply, and the Power indicator on the foot massager will flash white, followed by a beep, indicating that the foot and calf massager is in standby mode.
- (2) Tap () on the foot massager or press the Power button on the remote control to turn on both the foot massager and calf massager.
- (3) Select massage options pressing the corresponding buttons on the control panel or remote control according to your preference.
- *If the calf massager and foot massager work together, the calf massager's time will be controlled by the foot massager's.
- (4) Press the Power button on the remote control or tap the Power button on the control panel of the foot massager to turn off the foot and calf massager after the massage is complete.

Work Individually

Foot massager

- (1) Connect the power cord to the power supply, and the Power indicator will flash white, followed by a beep, indicating that the foot massager is in standby mode.
- (2) Tap (1) on the foot massager or press the Power button on the

remote control to turn on the foot massager.

- (3) Select massage options pressing the corresponding buttons on the control panel or remote control according to your preference.
- (4) Tap the Power button on the control panel of the foot massager or press the Power button on the remote control to turn the foot massager off after the foot massage is complete.

Calf massager

- (1) Long press the Power button on the control panel of the calf massager to turn the calf massager on, and the indicators will be on, followed by a beep.
- (2) Select massage options pressing the corresponding buttons on the control panel or remote control according to your preference.
- (3) Press the Power button on the control panel of the calf massager or the OFF button on the remote control to turn the calf massager off after the calf massage is complete.
- * See the table below for the default settings of the device.

Note:

- a. You can use the foot massager and calf massager together or separately.
- b. Tapping the Power button on the control panel of the foot massager can turn on both the foot massager and calf massager if they work together, but the Power button on the calf massager can control the calf massager only.

3. Memory Function

(1) Foot massager

The foot massager will recall the last settings once turned on again. However, the foot massager will go back to the default settings if you reconnect the power cord to the power supply and then turn it on or it is in DIY mode before switching off.

(2) Calf massager

The calf massager will recall the last settings once turned on again. However, the calf massager will go back to the default settings if it is in DIY mode before switching off.

App Guide

1. Download the Renpho Health App

Search "Renpho Health" from Apple Store / Google Play or scan the QR code below to download the App.





* The "Renpho Health" App may appear slightly different due to continuous updates.

2. Log in/Sign up

- a. Log in directly with an existing Renpho App account.
- b. If you don't have any Renpho App account, tap "Sign up".

Use your email address to register a new account of the Renpho Health App and complete your profile information.

3. Add Device

- * Enable Bluetooth on your smartphone. (Location information is also required by Android System.)
- * If you wish to pair the App with the foot and calf massager or the foot massager only, connect the power cord of the device to the power supply before pairing.
- * If you wish to pair the App with the calf massager only, turn on the calf massager before pairing.

Method 1

- a. Refresh the "Home Page" and a window will pop up on the phone screen.
- b. Tap "Pair" to pair the App with the device.



Method 2

- a. Tap "+" on the top right corner of the "Home Page" to connect manually.
- b. Select "Massage" and tap "2 in 1 Foot and Calf Massager".
- c. A window will pop up on the phone screen and tap "+" to pair the App with the device.








4. Massage

(1) Foot Massage

- a. Tap the "Device Page" to choose "2 in 1 Foot and Calf Massager R-D002RS".
- b. Tap " on the homepage bottom to turn on/off the foot massager.
- Select massage options among Time, Air Intensity, Knead Intensity and Heat according to your preference.





(2) Calf Massage


- a. Tap the "Device Page" to choose "2 in 1 Foot and Calf Massager R-D002RS".
- b. Tap " " on the right top of the calf massage section to turn on/off the calf massager.
- Select massage options among Mode, Air Intensity and Heat according to your preference.





5. DIY Mode

- a. Tap "DIY" on the homepage to DIY your massage session.
- b. Tap "Add" on the "DIY List Page" to add your customized settings.
 On the "Add Stage Page", you can enter a name for your customized settings and choose a time range.
- c. Tap " 🙋 " to edit the massage stage.



* Edit the massage stage

- a. Tap "Timer" to choose a duration time.
- b. Select the massage options for foot and calf massage according to your preference.
 - *For foot massage, if the 2-tier or above air intensity is selected, you can choose the compression hold time and turn on/off the roller during the compression holding process.
- c. Tap "Save" to save the massage stage.
- d. If you want to add more stages, tap "Add Stage" and repeat the above steps. If not, just tap "Save" on the "Add Stage Page" to save the edited stage.
- e. Tap "Apply" to experience the DIY mode.
- f. If you want to exit the DIY mode, tap "Exit the current mode".




Note:

- a. If both the foot massager and calf massager are connected to the App for DIY mode and there is any further operation on them via the control panel or remote control, the DIY running page will exit on the App automatically.
- b. The DIY settings do not support the memory function. The foot and calf massager will go back to the default settings if it is in DIY mode before switching off.
- c. If the total time of all stages is less than the time range, the device will cycle back to the first stage until the set massage time is over.

d. The longer compression hold time you select, the more pressure you may get. It is recommended to switch the roller off if you feel any discomfort during the compression holding process.

6. Favorite Setting

- * Ensure that the device is on before setting your favorites.
- a. On the homepage, select the massage options for foot and calf massage according to your preference.
- b. Tap " C+" on the top right corner of the homepage to enter a name for your favorite settings and confirm.
- c. Tap "Favorites" on the homepage to view your favorite list and tap "Apply" to start your favorite massage session.



Charging

*Only the calf massager can be charged.



1. Low Battery Reminder

When the calf massager is in low battery, its lowest battery level indicator will flash.

2. Charging the Calf Massager

Method 1:

Place the calf massager back to the charging port of the foot massager and connect the power cord to the power supply to charge the calf massager.

Method 2:

Charge the calf massager using a Type-C cable (not included) and a DC 5V 2A mobile charger (not included). (The Type-C charging port is on the bottom of the calf massager.)

*The calf massager can support up to 100min on each full charge.

Maintenance and Cleaning

- 1. The use of non-rated voltage is prohibited.
- 2. Unplug the device after use.
- 3. It is prohibited for non-professional personnel to repair the device or replace its parts.
- 4. The device is temperature protected. It will automatically shut off when the temperature exceeds the safety limit.
- 5. Unplug the device before cleaning.
- 6. Use a soft cotton cloth and neutral detergent to clean the main body.
- 7. The covers are detachable and washable. Unzip and wash them.
