Pairing name: TWS Bluetooth version: 5.4

1. Pairing method: Press and hold the POWER button for 3 seconds to turn on the device. The two headphones will automatically pair when the red and blue flashing lights turn on. If the red and blue lights in the left and right ears turn off, it indicates that the pairing is successful.

Function key: POWER

2. Power on prompt sound: Power on

3. Shutdown prompt sound: Shutdown

4. Connection prompt sound: Connection successful

5. Disconnect prompt sound: The link has been disconnected

6. Low battery warning sound: Low battery, please charge in a timely manner

7. Key functions: Long press for 3 seconds to turn on/off, click on music playback, pause, answer incoming calls, hang up calls, long press up and down songs, double-click add and subtract, three clicks on SIRI, and four clicks on replay.
