

3. Get Started

3.1 Requirements

To use the Find My app to locate this FindWallet+ wallet, make sure that:

 Your iPhone iPod touche is running with IOs 14.5 or later, or iPad with iPadOs 14.5 or later. The latest version of IOS, iPadOS, or macOs is recommended.

· Wi-Fi or Cellular connection is strong.

3.2 Power On / Off

Press the Function Button once (1) to power it on, and it will play a ringring chime indicating it is powered on.

Press and hold the Function Button for at least three (3) seconds to power it off, and it will play a low-pitch ringring chime indicating it is powered off.

### 4. Using Your FindWallet+

4.1 Add Your FindWallet+

Open Find My app on your iPhone (or other supported devices).

Place your FindWallet+ wallet next to your IPhone.

Press the Function Button twice (2) to ready to connect, one beep will be heard.

Tap +, then tap "Add Other Item"

Once your FindWallet+ is discovered, tap "Connect

 Enter a name and choose an Emoil, tap "Continue" Tap "Agree" to allow the FindWallet+ link to your Apple ID.

If you need to connect your FindWallet+ to a new device, remove the connection from current device firstly.

4.2 Locate Your FindWallet+

1) Use "Play Sound" to find it when it's nearby:

Open Find My app.

• Tap the "Items" tab.

Tap on your FindWallet+ from the items list.

Tan "Play Sound" to make it play continuous chord tone alerts.

Tap "Stop Sound" to stop the alerts once you find it.

2) Use "Directions" to find its location when far away:

Open Find My app.

Tap the "Items" tab.

• Tap on your FindWallet+ from the Items list Your FindWallet+'s location will appear on the map, and a most recent location and time stamp appears under its name.

. Tap "Directions" to navigate to it's location.

4.3 Enable "Notification" 1) Enable "Notify When Found"

Open Find My app.

· Tap the "Items" tab. Tap on your FindWallet+ from the items list.

Swipe upwards to bring up the full settings.
 Under "Notifications", enable the "Notify When Found" toggle.

When your FindWallet+ is seen by another Find Mynetwork, you will receive a notification of its location.



2) Enable "Notify When Left Behind" e Onen Find My ann.

Tap the "items" tab.

 Tap on your FindWallet+ from the items list . Swipe upwards to bring up the full settings.

 Under "Notifications", enable the "Notify When Left Behind' toggle. You will receive a notification when you leave your FindWallet+ behind and it's out of range of your device.

4.4 Enable "Lost Mode"

· Open Find My app.

Tap on your FindWallet+ that you want to mark as lost.

Swipe upwards to bring up the full settings.

Under "Lost Mode", tap "Enable", then tap "Continue" Enter your phone number or small address, tap "Next"

Tap "Activate" to enable "Lost Mode".

To disable "Lost Mode", under "Lost Mode", tap "Enabled"
 "then tap "Turn Off Lost Mode" popup to turn off.

4.6 Remove Your FindWallet+

· Open Find My app.

. Tap on your FindWallet+ that you want to remove. Swipe upwards to bring up the full settings.

Tap "Remove Item", follow the onscreen instructions to remove, once removed, your FindWallet+ will emit aringring chime.

4.7 Reset Your FindWallet+ After successfully remove your FindWallet+ from Find My app, press the Function Button four (4) times rapidly, then hold it a fifth time until you hear a ringring chime.


The FindWallet+ is now reset successfully, and ready to be paired to a new Apple ID.

4.8 Anti-Stalking Feature If other's FindWallet+ is mixed with your belongings, it will be detected with you when they are out of range from their owner, and you will receive a notification by following way:

If you have an iPhone, iPad, or iPad touch, Find My app will send a notification to your Apple device, tap the Detecteditem and tap "Play Sound" to find it.
