






Get Started</p> <p>3.1 Requirements</p> <p>To use the Find My app to locate this FindWallet+ wallet, make sure that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your iPhone iPod touch is running with iOS 14.5 or later, or iPad with iPadOS 14.5 or later. The latest version of iOS, iPadOS, or macOS is recommended. Wi-Fi or Cellular connection is strong. <p>3.2 Power On/ Off</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Press the Function Button once (1) to power it on, and it will play a ringing chime indicating it is powered on. Press and hold the Function Button for at least three (3) seconds to power it off, and it will play a low-pitch ringing chime indicating it is powered off. <p>4. Using Your FindWallet+</p> <p>4.1 Add Your FindWallet+</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open Find My app on your iPhone (or other supported devices). Place your FindWallet+ wallet next to your iPhone. Press the Function Button twice (2) to ready to connect, one beep will be heard. Tap < then tap "Add Other Item" <p style="text-align: center;">03</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Once your FindWallet+ is discovered, tap "Connect" Enter a name and choose an Emoji, tap "Continue" Tap "Agree" to allow the FindWallet+ link to your Apple ID. Tap <, then tap "Add Other Item" <p> If you need to connect your FindWallet+ to a new device, remove the connection from current device firstly.</p> <p>4.2 Locate Your FindWallet+</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Use "Play Sound" to find it when it's nearby: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open Find My app. Tap the "Items" tab. Tap on your FindWallet+ from the items list. Tap "Play Sound" to make it play continuous chord tone alerts. Tap "Stop Sound" to stop the alerts once you find it. Use "Directions" to find its location when far away: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open Find My app. Tap the "Items" tab. Tap on your FindWallet+ from the items list Your FindWallet+ location will appear on the map, and a most recent location and time stamp appears under its name. Tap "Directions" to navigate to it's location. <p style="text-align: center;">04</p>

<p>4.3 Enable "Notification"</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Enable "Notify When Found" Open Find My app. Tap the "Items" tab. Tap on your FindWallet+ from the items list. Swipe upwards to bring up the full settings. Under "Notifications", enable the "Notify When Found" toggle. When your FindWallet+ is seen by another Find My network, you will receive a notification of its location. <p> "Notify When Found" can only be activated when your FindWallet+ is out of range of your device.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2) Enable "Notify When Left Behind" Open Find My app. Tap the "Items" tab. Tap on your FindWallet+ from the items list Swipe upwards to bring up the full settings. Under "Notifications", enable the "Notify When Left Behind" toggle. You will receive a notification when you leave your FindWallet+ behind and it's out of range of your device. <p>4.4 Enable "Lost Mode"</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open Find My app. Tap the "Items" tab. Tap on your FindWallet+ that you want to mark as lost. <p style="text-align: center;">05</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swipe upwards to bring up the full settings. Under "Lost Mode", tap "Enable", then tap "Continue" Enter your phone number or email address, tap "Next" Tap "Activate" to enable "Lost Mode". To disable "Lost Mode", under "Lost Mode", tap "Enable" then tap "Turn Off Lost Mode" popup to turn off. <p> 1) When "Lost Mode" is enabled, "Notify When Found" will be automatically enabled.</p> <p>2) When "Lost Mode" is enabled, your FindWallet+ is blocked and cannot be paired to a new device.</p> <p>4.5 Rename Your Find My Passport</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open Find My app. Tap the "Items" tab. Tap on your FindWallet+ that you want to change the name. Swipe upwards to bring up the full settings. Tap "Rename Item" Select a name from the list or select Custom Name. Type a custom name for your FindWallet+, and select an Emoji which you'd like to. Tap "Done" <p style="text-align: center;">06</p>	<p>4.6 Remove Your FindWallet+</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open Find My app. Tap the "Items" tab. Tap on your FindWallet+ that you want to remove. Swipe upwards to bring up the full settings. Tap "Remove Item", follow the onscreen instructions to remove, once removed, your FindWallet+ will emit a ringing chime. <p>4.7 Reset Your FindWallet+</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> After successfully remove your FindWallet+ from Find My app, press the Function Button four (4) times rapidly, then hold it a fifth time until you hear a ringing chime. The FindWallet+ is now reset successfully, and ready to be paired to a new Apple ID. <p>4.8 Anti-Stalking Feature</p> <p>If other's FindWallet+ is mixed with your belongings, it will be detected with you when they are out of range from their owner, and you will receive a notification by following way:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you have an iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch, Find My app will send a notification to your Apple device, tap the DetectItem and tap "Play Sound" to find it.
