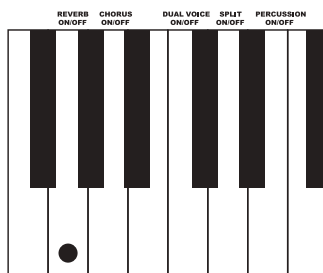

■ CHORD ACCOMPANIMENT

- a. Press “START/STOP , SYNC START” button to start performance of selected rhythms

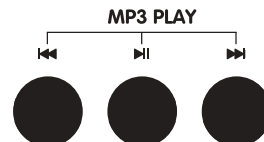

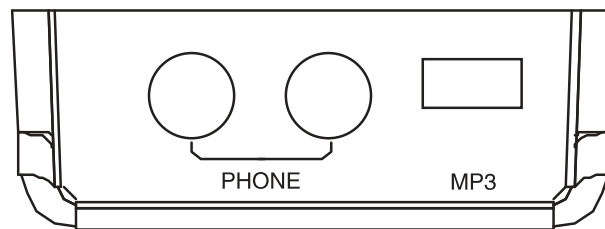
