











# **Charging the Microphone**

Insert one end of the included USB charging cable into the charging port on your microphone.







# **Bluetooth Pairing**

- 1. Press and hold the power button to power the microphone ON/OFF.
- 2. Go to the Bluetooth settings menu on your phone. Make sure that Bluetooth is turned on. Connect to the device listed as "ST64-KM-TA"
- 3. Your microphone's True Wireless Pairing function allows you to pair two microphones together.

To pair two microphones together, first power them both on. Double-press the power button on both microphones. After a few moments, they will automatically pair together. Once paired together, you will hear an audible noise prompt. You can then proceed to pair your microphones with your Bluetooth audio device.





# **Using the Microphone**

#### Powering ON/OFF:

Press and hold the power button to turn ON/OFF.

#### Play/Pause:

Press the Play/Pause button to pause the currently playing music.

## **Adjusting Volume:**

Press and hold the Volume Up button to increase the volume. Press and hold the Volume Down button to decrease the volume.

## Adjusting Mic Volume and Reverb:

Push the Remix switch up to increase reverb and push it down to decrease it. Push the Mic Volume switch up to increase volume and push it down to decrease.

#### **Voice Changer:**

Press and hold the Voice change button to change between different voice modes.

#### Liaht:

Press the Voice change button to turn ON/OFF the microphone light.

#### **Changing Modes:**

Your microphone has a USB Port and a Micro SD Memory Card Slot. When a USB thumb drive or jump drive is inserted into the USB Port, your microphone will play any .MP3 music file stored on the drive. When a Micro SD memory card is inserted into the microSD Card Slot, your microphone will play any .MP3 music file stored on the card.
