IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTION

3) Do not use while bathing or in a shower.

When using this device, all instructions and basic precautions outlined in this document should be followed. Read all instructions before using (this appliance).

DANGER - To reduce the risk of electric shock: 1) Always unplug this device from the electrical outlet immediately after use and before
