The manual systemically introduces the functions, use techniques and announcements, please read this manual carefully before your operation.





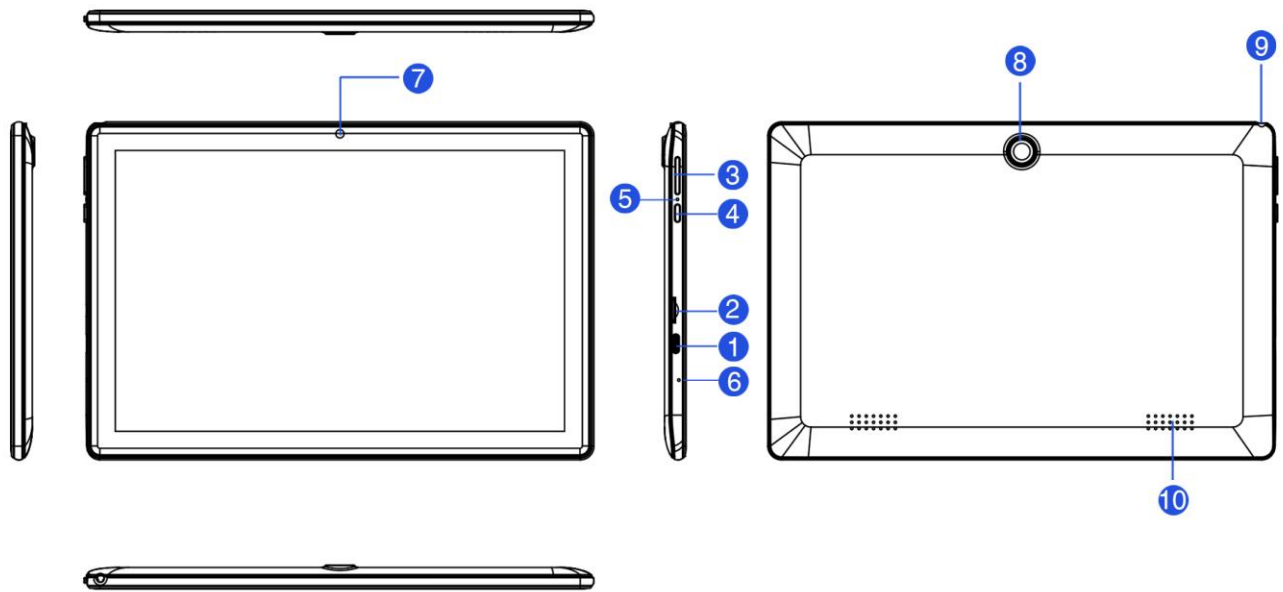
# 2.Quick Start Guide

## 2. 1. Keys Function

**Keys Function Description:**

Power button	Short press to sleep/wake up, long press to startup and shutdown.
Volume + (up)	Increase the volume
Volume - (down)	Decrease the volume
HOME button (home) 	Click it in any interface will return to main interface.
Back button (back) 	Click it in any interface will return to previous menu
Setting button 	Display recently browsed history; double click this button, you can switch between the last 2 applications

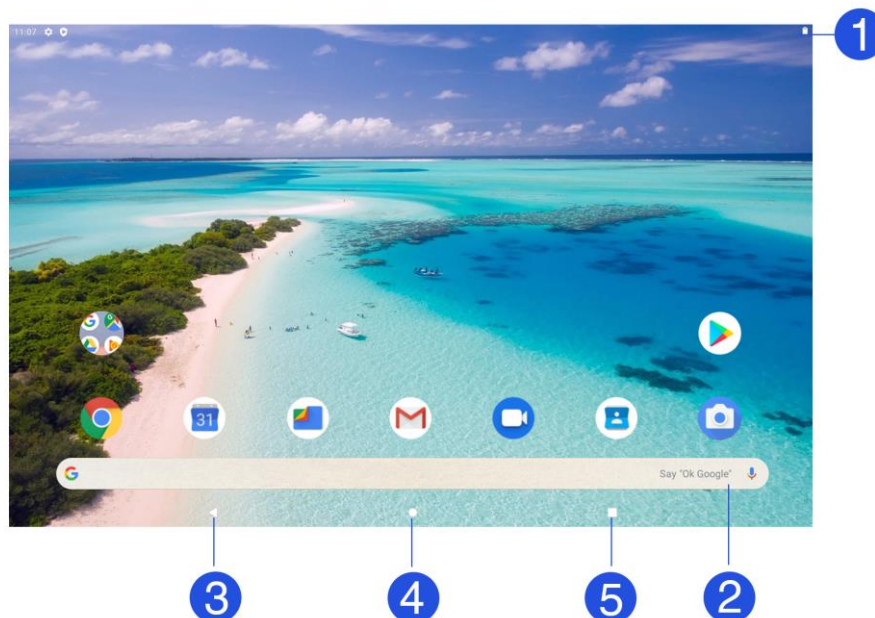

## 2. 2. Quick Startup

1. Please remove the film on the tablet.
2. Press and hold the power button for 5 seconds to power on the tablet.
3. If the tablet cannot be powered on at your first try, please charge it for more than 30 minutes, then try again.
4. Swipe up on the screen to unlock the tablet.
5. Select your language at the first setup. If you skip it, go to Settings > System > Languages & input> Languages > +Add a language to change the language, or go to Settings > System > Advanced > Reset options > Erase all data (factory reset) to make a factory reset.
6. Gestures for using this tablet.
  - \* Tap: tap an application once to select and launch it.
  - Tap and hold: tap and hold on the screen or application to show the relevant options.
  - Slide / Swipe: slide the screen leftward / rightward or swipe the screen upward / downward to switch among different screens or interfaces.
  - \* Drag: tap and hold an application on a screen, then drag it to your desired screen or to remove / uninstall.
  - \* Pinch & Spread: zoom in / out the current photos or web content.

Main interface as below picture, long press the blank and it will popup windows to set wallpaper, folder, widgets, and shortcut.



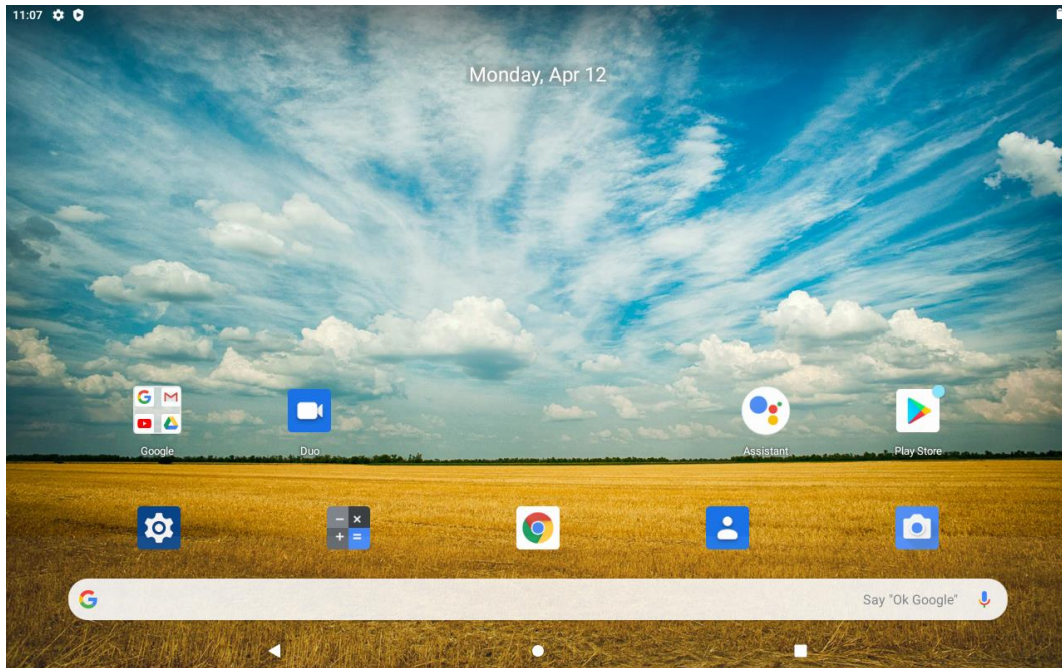

# The shortcut icons management in desktop application.

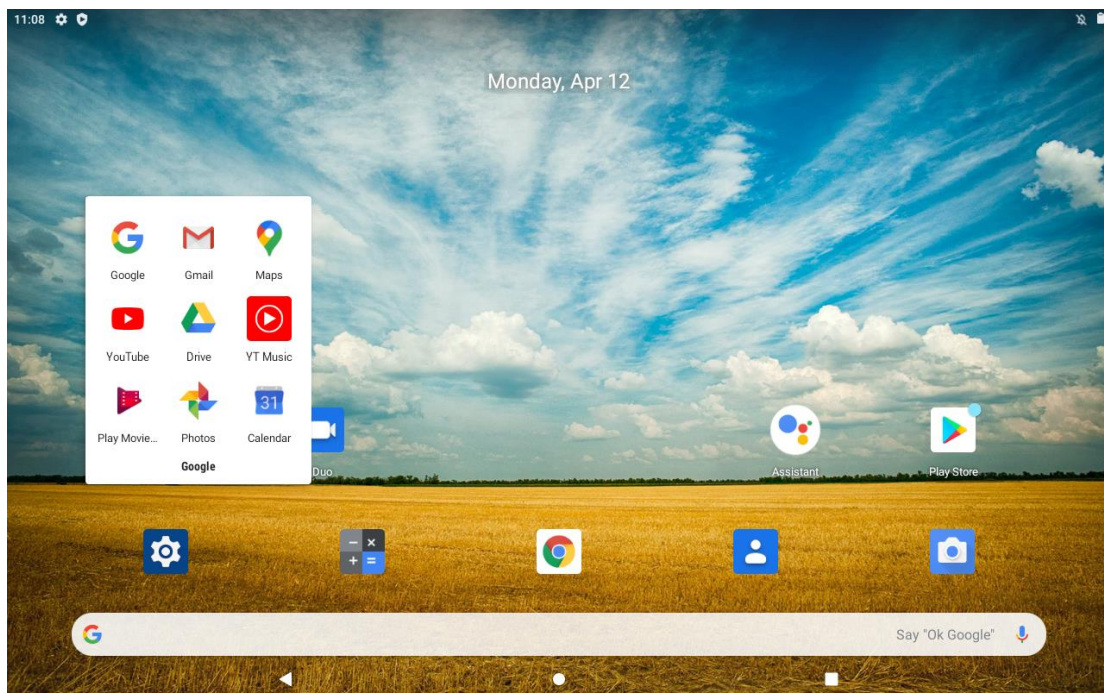
## Create folder icon in desktop

- 1) Drag the icons need to be put together on one icon(can also overlay several icons) as Picture;



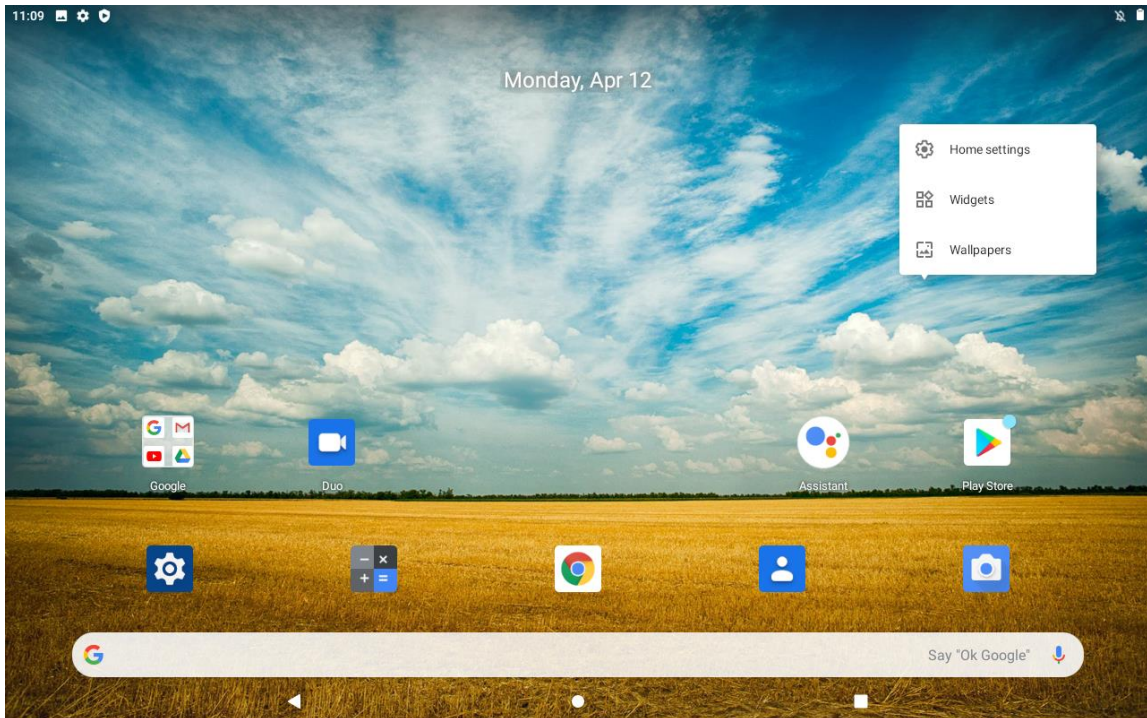

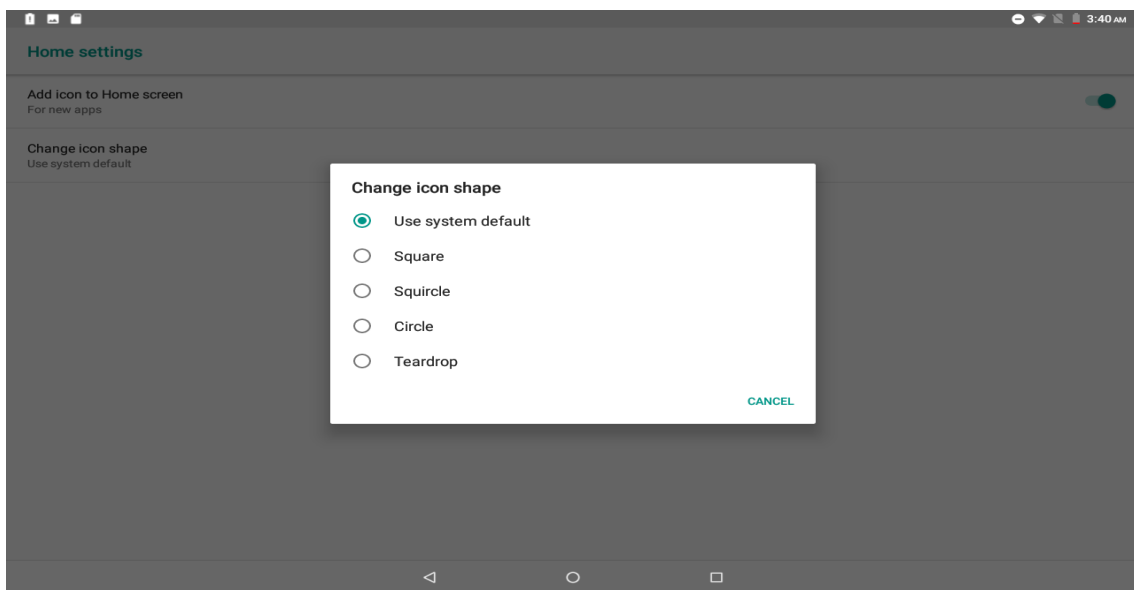

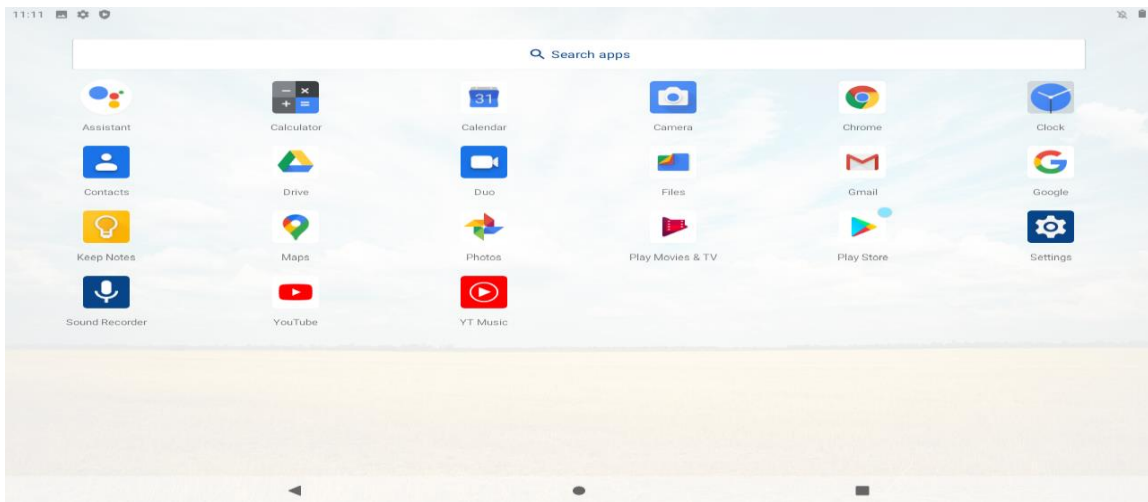
## Remove the icons in desktop

## 2. 5. USB Connection

### MID storage configuration

1. Before transmitting documents, you have to conduct storage configuration for your MID:
2. Connect the MID and computer by USB cable, the reminder column will show the remind information.
3. Open the reminder board; please view the MID status and reminder to learn how to open the board.
4. In the reminder board, click the "USB for file transfer", it will as below Picture, then click "File transfers".
5. Now the USB is connected successfully.

### Copy the document into memory card

1. Connect the MID to computer with USB cable.
2. As MID storage configuration, it is connected with computer successfully.
3. Open the “My computer” in your computer, check the items in “MTP devices” .
4. Copy the documents you need into “MTP devices”.
5. After copying finishes, unplug the USB can.

## 2. 6. Typing Words

When you start the procedure or choose the words or numbers edition, it will show the screen keyboard.

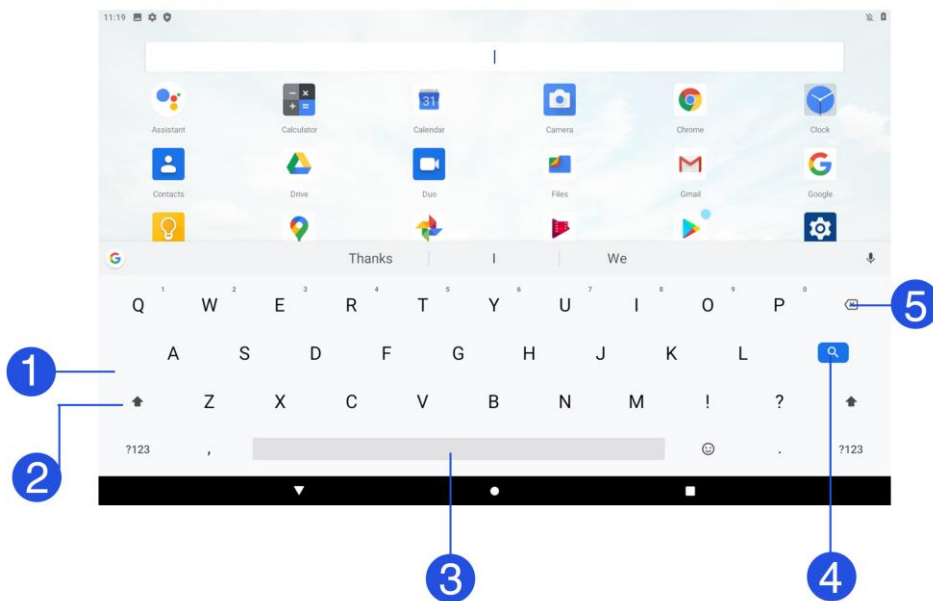
The keyboard contains below typing options:

## 2. 7. Operation Technique

### Enter widgets interface

In the application interface, click widgets on the above of screen, or slide the screen, it will switch into widgets interface. Long press any widget to create its shortcut, then you can enter into the application through the shortcut icon.

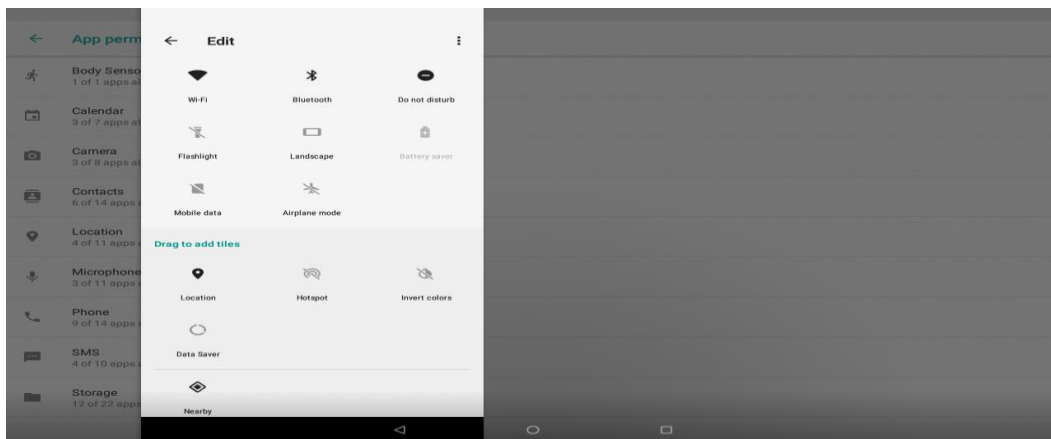
### Create application shortcut icons in the desktop

Remind: If the target position has no space, the widget won't be add in the main screen.

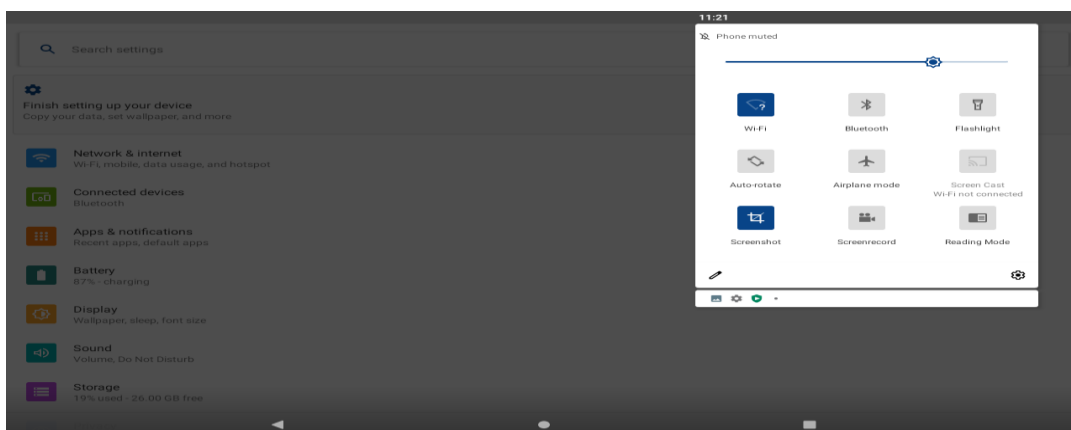
## 2. 8. Quick Setting

Swipe-down gesture from the top of the screen, there are nine shortcuts icons, such as Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, Auto-rotate, and so on. In the full Quick Settings list you can also tap the edit button at the bottom right to rearrange the tiles or replace them with others, as Picture. The optional extras list is pretty minimal: Just Hotspot, Data saver and Invert colors. But developers are now able to create custom Quick Settings tiles for their apps, which will definitely make things a lot more interesting in the coming mouths.

## 3. 1. Network and Internet

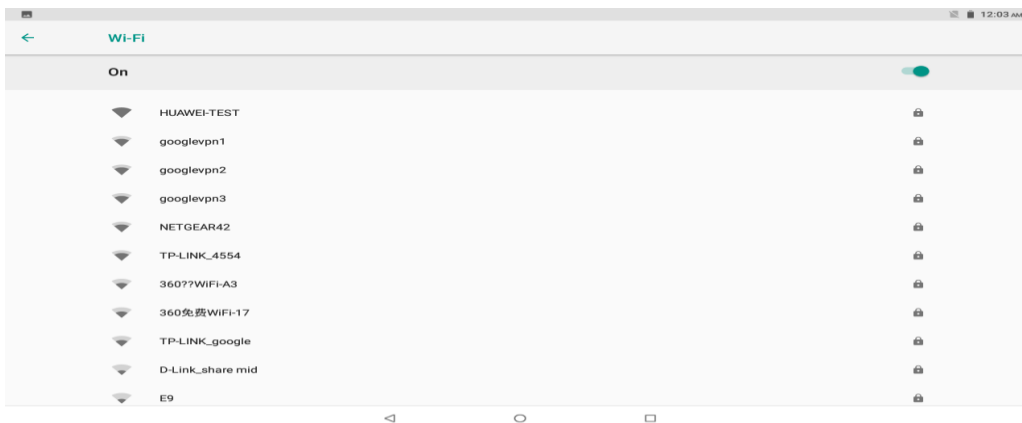
Reset Wi-Fi、 mobile & Bluetooth

### 4.1-1 Connect Wi-Fi

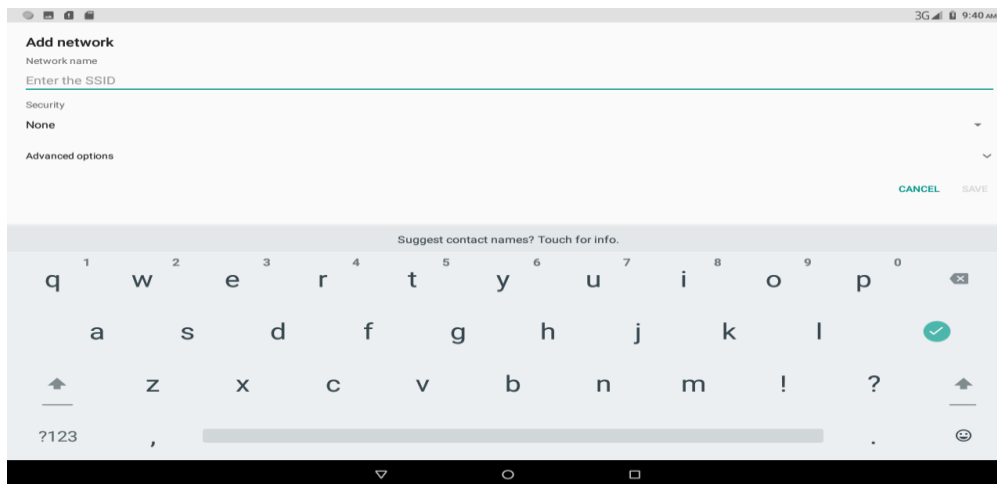
- 1) In the main menu or interface, choose setting application procedure.

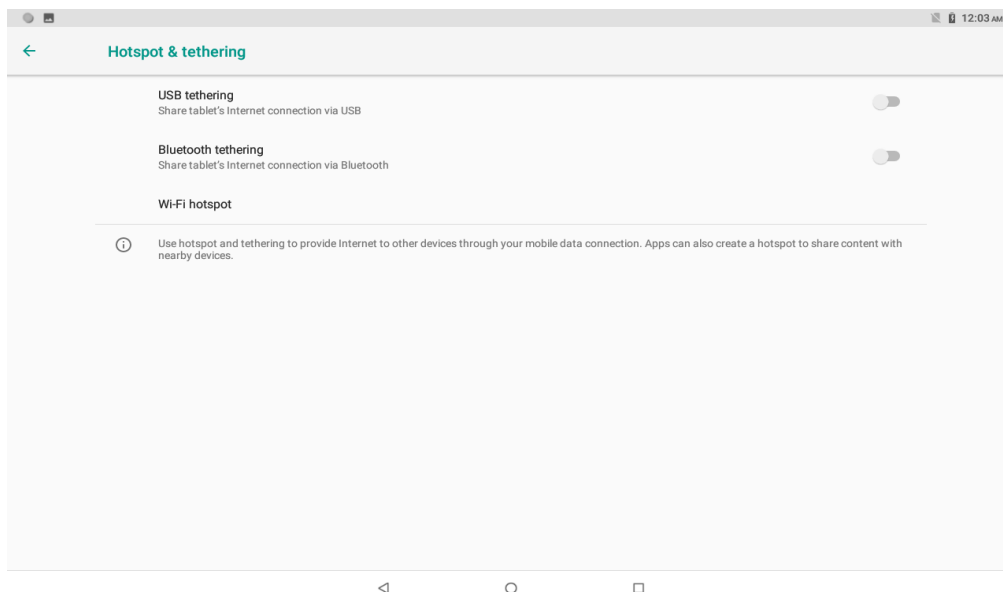

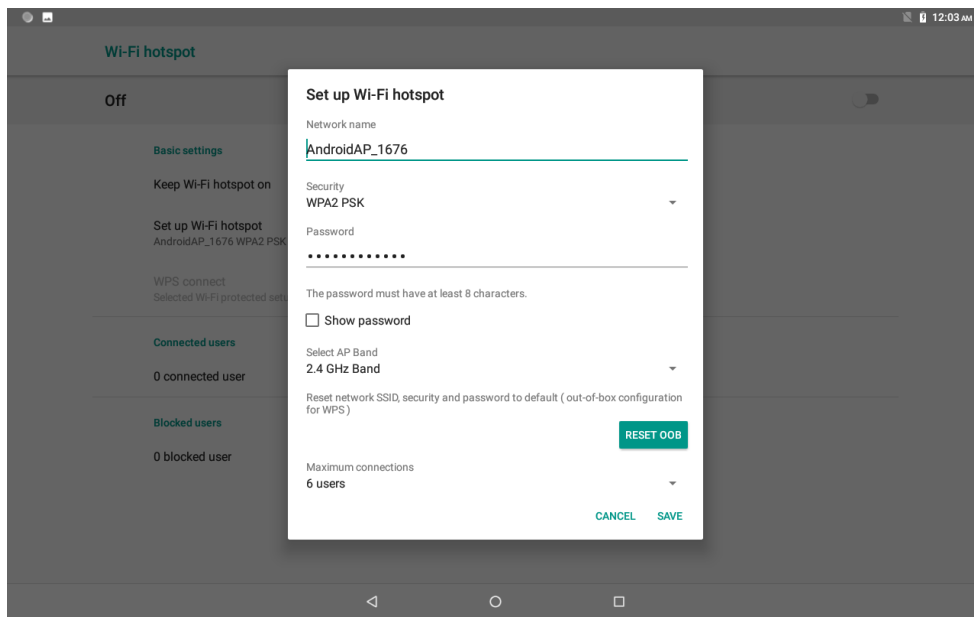

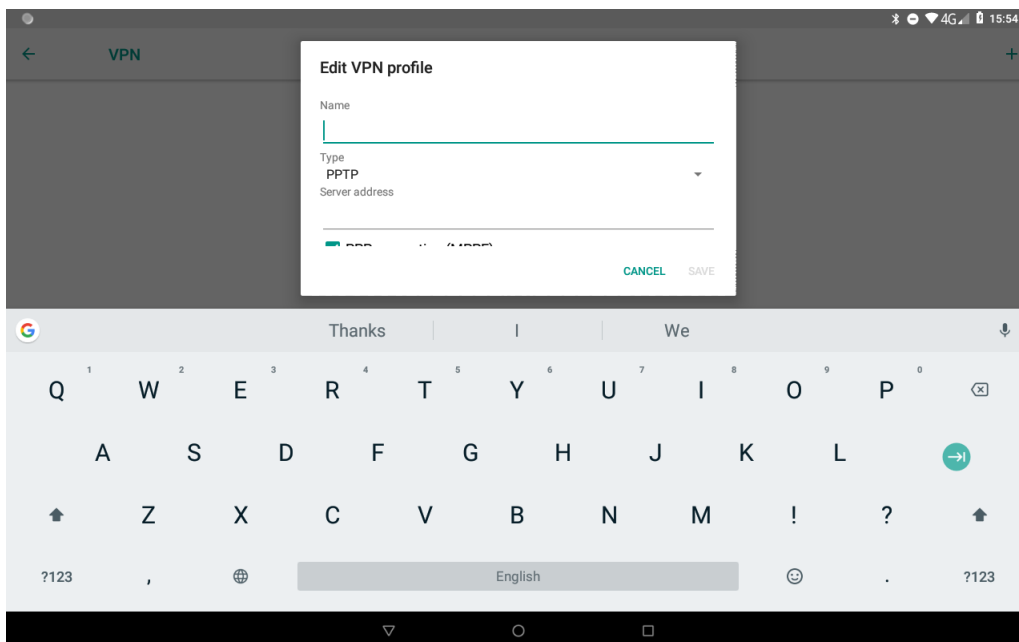

5. Set passwords you want to, password should be more than 8 numbers.

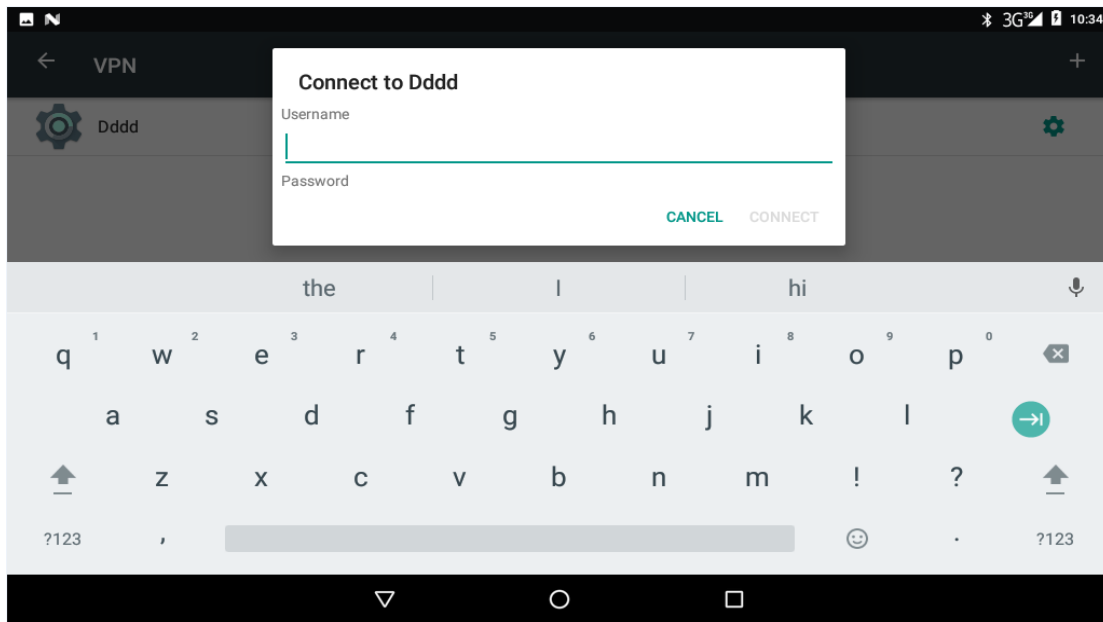
#### 4.1-3 VPN

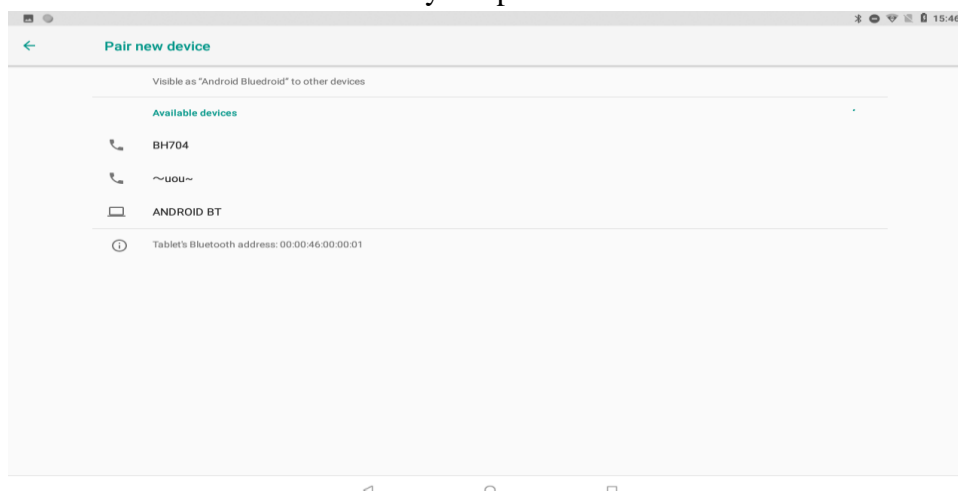
#### 4.1-4 Airplane Mode

## 3. 2. Bluetooth

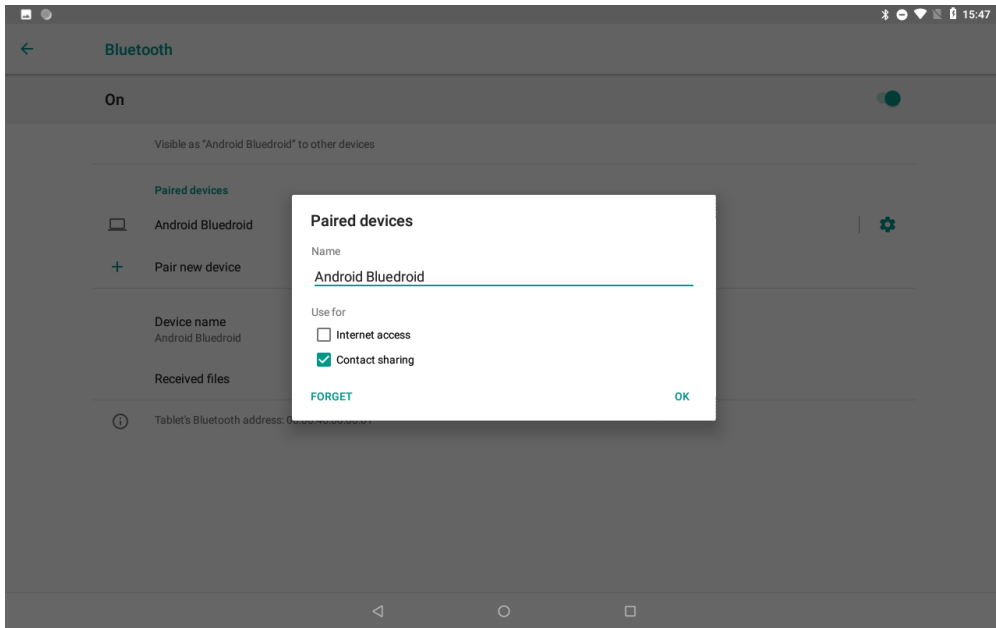
### Bluetooth Function Operation

- After match successfully, choose the operation you want to, click  to enter into Picture

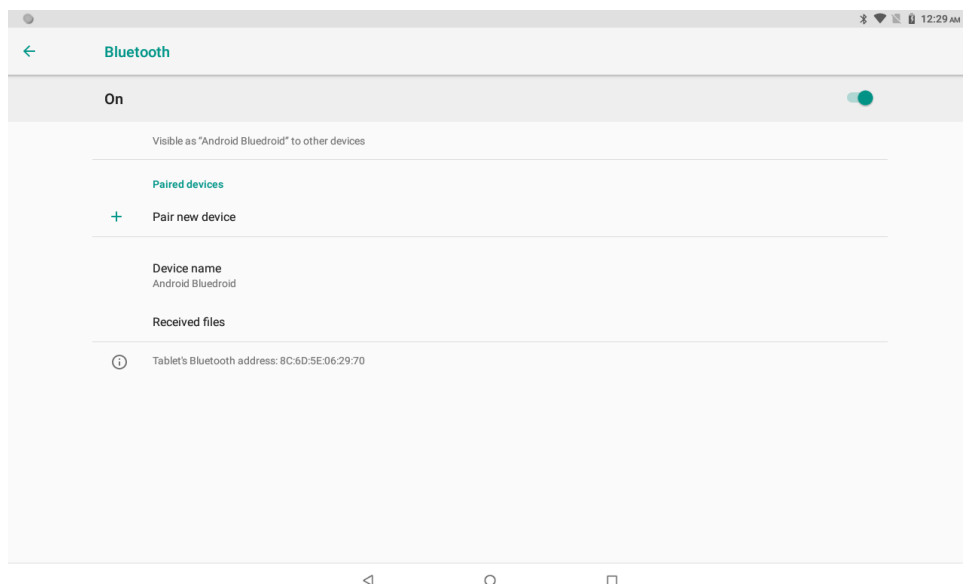

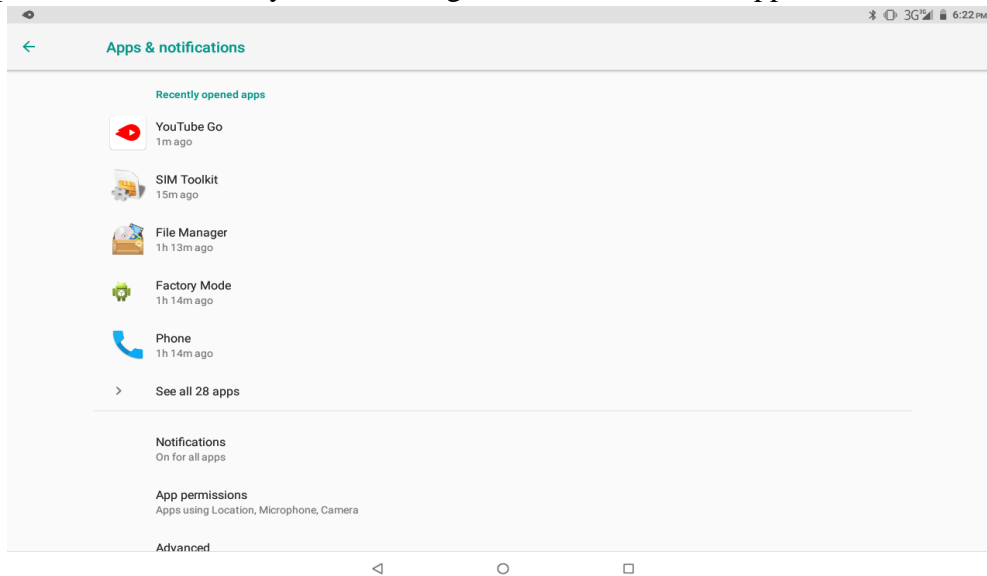

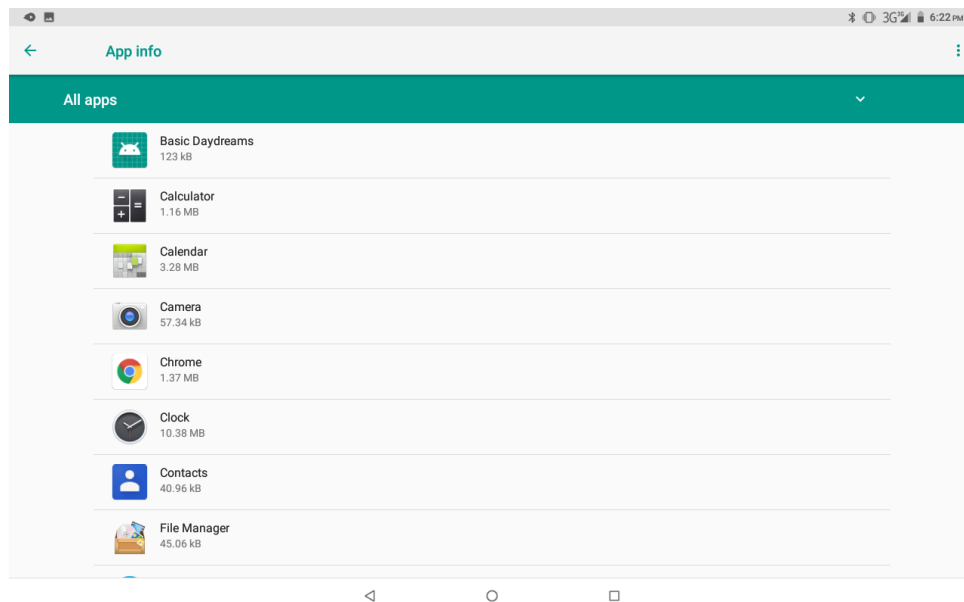
1. Click setting application in Apps.

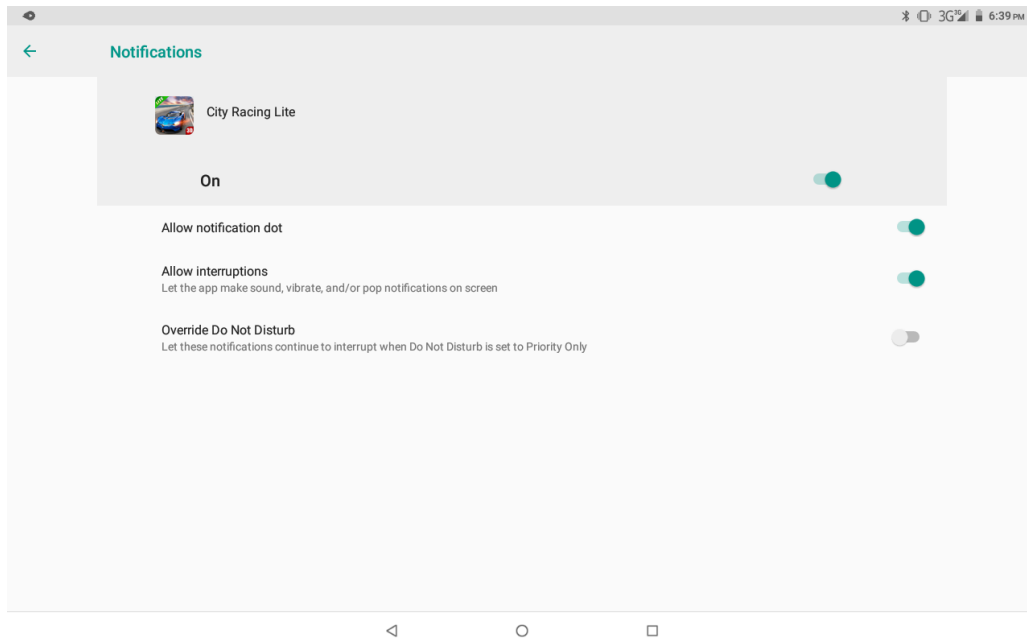

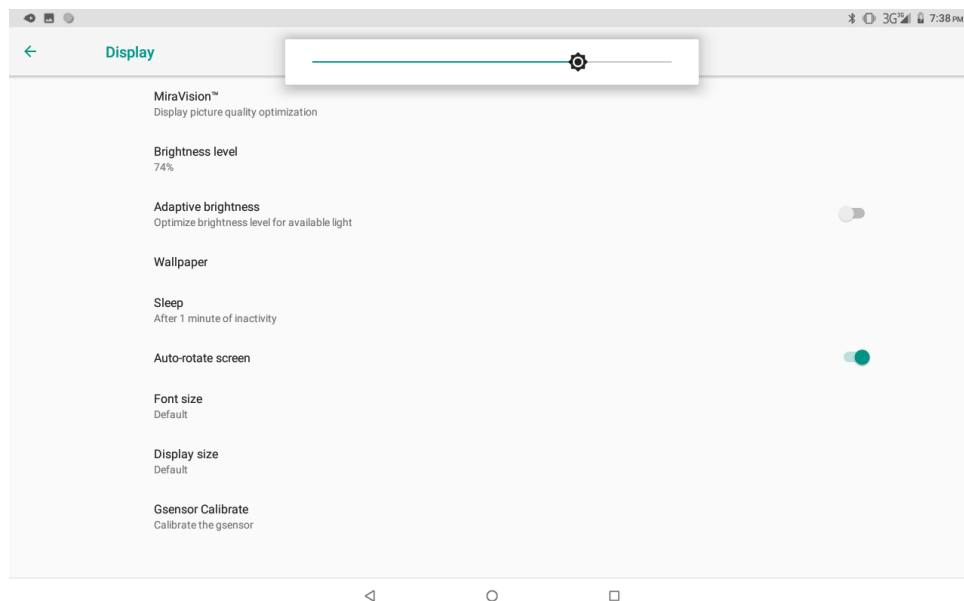

## 3. 4. Display

- 1) Click setting application.

- 3) Click sleep.
- 4) Set the sleep time as you want

Click **font size** to adjust the size of the text

#### 4.4-6 Display size

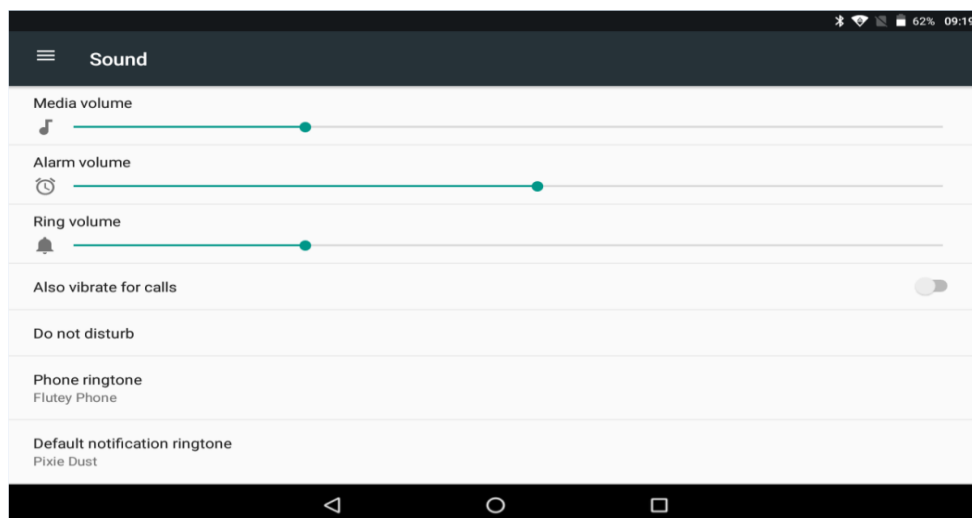
Click **Display size** to adjust the size of the icons

### 1. Vibrate

In picture click **Also vibrate for calls**, MID will vibrate when someone calls you.

### 2. Volume

In picture click volume, you can set ringtone, media, and alarm volume

## 3. 6. Security & Location

### 4.6-1 Set locked screen

Lock the touch screen by unlock icon or password to protect your MID.

**Note:** After setting screen locked, you should enter the pass code each time when you startup or screen is locked

#### Set unlocked picture

- 1) Click setting application in main interface.
- 2) Click **security**.
- 3) Click **screen lock**.
- 4) Choose **pattern** in text setting area.
- 5) Click next following the remind message.
- 6) The unlocked pattern board pop up, there are nine touch spots, connect 4 points from vertical, horizontal or diagonal direction. Move your finger from the screen when finish. The system will record yours new unlock pattern.
- 7) Click continue;
- 8) When you see the reminder, enter the unlock pattern, then click **confirm**.

#### Set unlock PIN code

- 1) Click setting application in main interface.
- 2) Click **security**.
- 3) Click **screen lock**.
- 4) Choose **PIN** in text setting area.
- 5) Enter new PIN code(numbers) and click **continue**.
- 6) Enter new PIN code again and click **confirm**.

#### Set unlock password

- 1) Click **setting application** in main interface.
- 2) Click safe.
- 3) Click screen locked.
- 4) Set password in text setting area.
- 5) Set new password(letters and numbers) and then click continue.
- 6) Enter the password again and the click **confirm**.

### 4.6-2 Location service

Click **setting**, select **Location**

## 3. 7. Users & Accounts

1. Select setting application
2. Open account and sync

3. Click add an account
4. After successfully load, it will open the sync function

## 3. 8. Accessibility

### 4.8-1. Font size

Click it to make system font large size

### 4.8-2. Click power button to end calls

When Click call, press “power” button, call will end but not hold.

### 4.8-3. Touch and hold delay

Click touch and hold delay to increase time,

### 4.8-4. Install webpage scrip

It will allow you install webpage scrip when you open system,, but it will increase the risk when you are browsing webpage.

## 3. 9. System

### 4.9-1 Language and Input Method

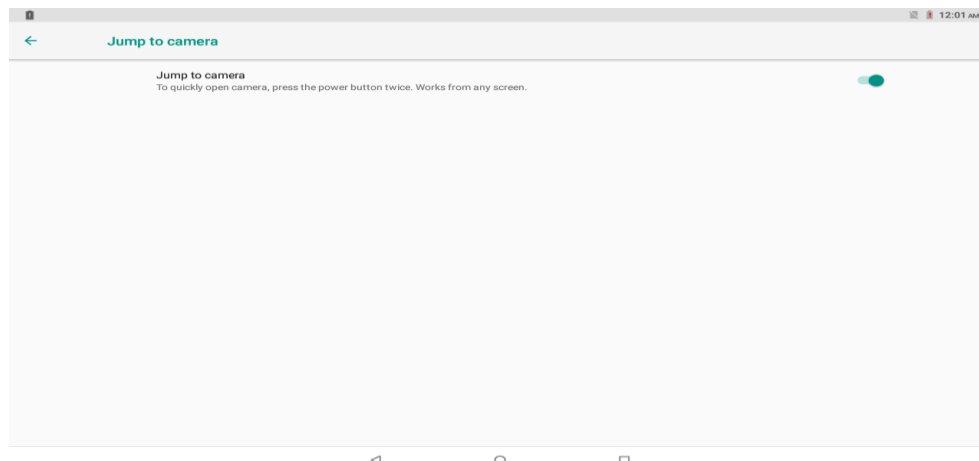

Operate it to open and close of this app as Picture



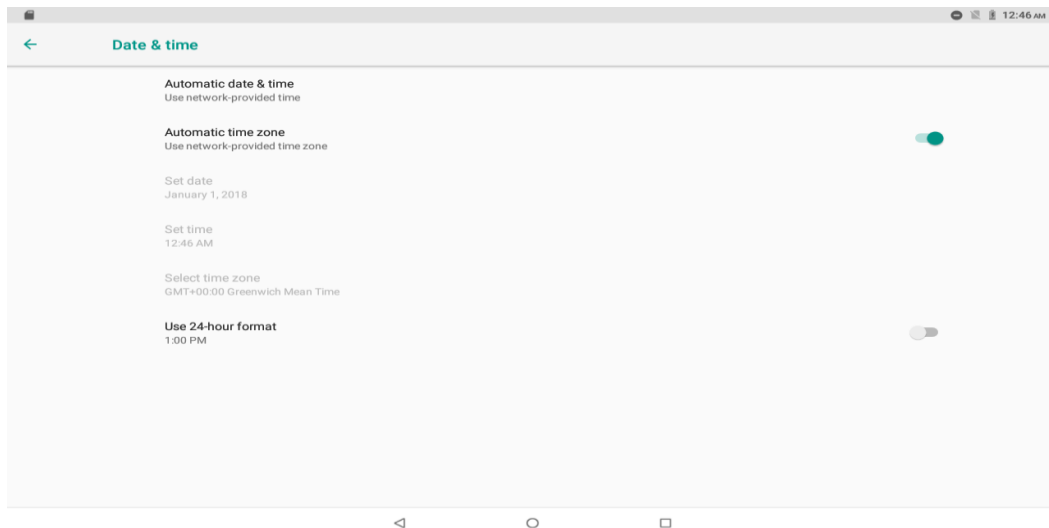

### 4.9-3 Date and Time

According to the preset, system will voluntarily apply the date, zone, and time provided by internet. as Picture.

Manual set date, time and zone

1. Click Setting application procedure.
2. Slide down the screen, then click **date and time**.
3. Turn off “auto setting of date and time”.
4. Turn off “auto setting zone”.
5. Click Zone Selecting, then choose the zone lists. Slide down the list to view more zones.
6. Click **Set date**, then click upper or down button to adjust date, month, and year, click **setting** when you finish selection.
7. Click **Set Time**, then click upper or down button to adjust hour and minute, click AM or PM to change morning or afternoon ( there is no such selection when you se 24-hour format). Click **Setting** to finish.
8. Click 24-hour format, switch between 12-hour or 24-hour format, the time format you choose will be used on the alarm clock.
9. Click date format setting, then choose the time format you want to show on MID.

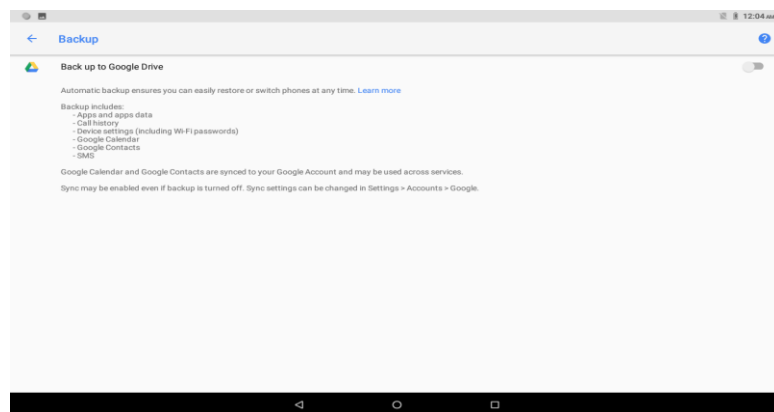

Connect WIFI and login your Google account, choose **backup my data**, system will backup your data into Google server. as Picture








### 3. 10. Factory Reset

Factory reset will erase all data from your tablet’s internal storage. Please back up important data on the device before resetting your tablet. Go to **Settings > System > Advanced > Reset Options > Erase all data (factory reset)**, then tap Erase all data to reset to the manufacturer’s default setting.

**If you forget your password, please follow the instructions to do a factory reset:**

## 4. Installation of Procedures

### 4. 1. Installation

#### Install the third party application procedure

1. Click “file manager” application procedure; choose the application procedure you
2. Hold the application procedure you need to install.
3. It popup **install**, click **install apk**.
4. Finish the installation as guide, it will operate.

**Note:** The third party procedure searched from internet to use on the system are all suffixed with **.apk**.

## 4. 2. Uninstall

### Uninstall application procedure

1. Click setting icon in main interface.
2. Click **apps**, list all the application procedures installed in the system.
3. Click the APK you want to uninstall, click **uninstall**.
4. Click **confirm** to finish uninstallation.

# 5. Trouble Shooting

Before contacting the service center, you are advised to follow the instructions below:

- To have optimal operation, fully charge the battery.
- To improve the device's performance, remove unnecessary files or apps on your device.
- To update your system software, use the **System > updates** command in your device's settings.
- To set your device to factory default, use the **Reset options** in the device's settings. All your device data will be lost permanently. It is strongly advised to fully back up your device before resetting.

### My device can't be switched on

- When the device can't be switched on, charge for at least 10 minutes to ensure the minimum battery power needed. Then switch it on again.

### My Device has not responded for several minutes

- If your device doesn't respond, turn off your device by pressing and holding the Power key until it turns off and then restart it again.

### My device turns off by itself

- When your device turns off by itself, make sure that the Power key is not accidentally pressed.
- Check the battery charge level.
- If it still doesn't work, Factory reset the device via the Reset options in the device's Settings. Make sure you have backed up your data.

### My device can't charge properly

- Make sure that you are using the proper charger that comes with the device.
- If your device has a removable battery, make sure that your battery is inserted properly and the battery terminal makes a good contact with the device. It must be inserted before plugging in the charger.
- Make sure that your battery is not completely discharged; if the battery power has been discharged for a long time, it may take around 10 minutes to display the battery charging indicator on the screen.
- Make sure that charging is carried out under normal conditions (0°C (32°F) to 55°C (131°F)).
- When abroad, check that the voltage input is compatible.
- Check that the charging port is secured or it's not damaged.

### My device can't connect to a network or "No service" is displayed

- Try connecting to the network by moving to another physical location.
- Verify the network coverage with your carrier in your current area.
- Make sure your devices setting is not in airplane mode.
- If you are away from your carrier's network, you may need to enable roaming in the device's settings to connect to other network. Roaming charges may apply.

### My device can't connect to the internet



- Make sure that Cellular Data internet service is available in your wireless service plan.
- Check your device's settings. Make sure Mobile network is enabled or Wi-Fi connected.
- Make sure that you are in a place with network coverage for cellular data or Wi-Fi internet connection.
- Try connecting at a later time or another location.

#### **I can't connect my device to my computer**

- Install Smart Suite.
- Check that your USB driver is installed properly.
- Open the Notification panel to check if the Smart Suite Agent has been activated.
- Check that you have marked the USB debugging checkbox.
- Check that your computer meets the requirements for Smart Suite installation.
- Make sure that you're using the right cable from the box.

#### **I can't download new files**

- Make sure that there is sufficient device storage space for your download.
- Select the microSD card as the location to store downloaded files.
- Check your subscription status with your carrier.

#### **The device can't be detected by others via Bluetooth**

- Make sure that Bluetooth is turned on and your device is visible to other users.
- Make sure that the two devices are within Bluetooth's detection range.

#### **The battery drains too fast**

- Make sure that you follow the complete charge time (minimum 200 minutes).
- After a partial charge, the battery level indicator may not be exact.
- Wait for at least 10 minutes after removing the charger to obtain an exact indication.
- Adjust the brightness of screen as appropriate.
- Extend the email auto-check interval for as long as possible.
- Update news and weather information on manual demand, or increase their auto-check interval.
- Exit background-running applications if they are not being used for extended periods of time.
- Deactivate Bluetooth, Wi-Fi, when not in use.

#### **The device becomes warm following game playing, internet surfing or running other complex applications**

- This heating is a normal consequence of the CPU handling excessive data. Ending the above actions will make your device return to normal temperature.

#### **After Factory data reset is performed, I can't use my device without entering Google account credentials**

- After reset is performed, you must enter the original Google account credentials that were used on this device.
- If you don't remember your Google account credentials, complete Google account recovery procedures.
- If you still cannot access your device, apply to the authorized repair center, but remember that it will not be regarded as warranty case.

#### **The device doesn't ring when a notification or message arrives**

- Make sure that Do Not Disturb mode (go to Settings > Sound > Do Not Disturb preferences) is not activated.
- Press the Volume keys to adjust volume.

#### **I forget some passwords/codes/keys on device**

- Perform Factory reset.
- If you still cannot access your device, apply to the authorized repair center, but remember that it will not be regarded as warranty case.
