$$S = \frac{P \times G}{4 \times \pi \times R^2}$$

Where:

S = power density

- P = power input to the antenna
- G = numeric gain of the antenna in the direction of interest relative to an isotropic radiator
- R = distance to the centre of radiation of the antenna
