

TURN ON

Take the two earbuds out of the charging case. They will automatically turn on. Once the earbuds have powered up, you should hear a sound indicating that they have automatically connected with one another.

TURN OFF

Long press the control button until LED turns red to indicate not in use, this will turn off your device. Earbuds will turn off automatically if away from case for more than 5 mins.

BLUETOOTH CONNECT

1. Power the device on. The earbuds will pair with one another automatically when they are turned on.
2. Turn on your device's Bluetooth from the Bluetooth menu and select "MV-EB5594".
3. When paired successfully the device will make a tone to confirm the connection has been made to your device.
4. Remember to turn the earbuds off after each use to ensure longest play time.

Note: The earbuds will reconnect automatically if your device has been paired previously. Disconnecting on your device's type and configuration, manual reconnection may be required each time.

CHARGING

1. **EARBUDS:** Just place the earbuds into the charging case. The earbuds will automatically enter charging mode if the cradle is charged or connected to the power supply. The earbuds will display a red LED light while they are charging, and turn off when they are fully charged.
2. **CASE:** Use the cable provided to connect the charging case to the power supply.

VOICE ASSISTANT

To activate the voice assistant (e.g., Siri), triple press the right earbud's control button.

*Note: If you hold control button for 2 seconds earbuds will power down.

FUNCTION KEYS

1. **PLAY/STOP MUSIC:** Briefly press either earbud's control button to start or stop playing music.
2. **VOLUME CONTROL:** Double press the left earbud's control button to increase volume and the right earbud's to decrease.
3. **MUSIC CONTROL:** Press and hold right earbud's control button for 1.5s to go to the next song and the left earbud's to go to the previous song.
4. **ANSWER CALL:** When a call is received, briefly press either earbud's control button. To hang up, briefly press once again.
5. **DECLINE CALL:** When a call is received, press and hold control button for 2 seconds*.
6. **REDIAL:** Triple press the left earbud's control button to redial the last number you called.
